DEAR BROTHERS & SISTERS IN CHRIST,

Today is Aldersgate Sunday. We commemorate John Wesley's spiritual awakening nearly 300 years ago that led to a mighty movement of evangelism and discipleship in England. This morning, we are privileged to have TRAC President, Rev Dr T. Jeyakumar as our online guest preacher.

It seems so long ago that we last met together on March 15, 2020 in church to worship God collectively, and be blessed by a richly rewarding message by Rev Benny Ho. I vividly remember that the air-conditioning system of the church sanctuary was working to the hilt as all the windows and the main doors of the sanctuary were opened wide. This was due to medical advice that Covid-19 is more likely to spread with ease in closed and confined spaces with air-conditioning. I never expected that a few days later till May, the church electricity bill would have decreased multiple times than the monthly average of 2019.

There has been excitement building up in the past two weeks about returning to worship God in the church building. This corresponds to a more lenient outlook by the government on MCO (CMCO) with many church members returning to their workplaces. However, Covid-19 still poses a diabolical threat to Malaysia and the world. Many health experts have warned the public not to let their guard down lest this virus rears its ugly head and viciously attacks humanity with greater severity. This was the main factor to guide CCM (Council of Churches, Malaysia) churches (which includes our Methodist Church) to remain cautious about re-opening our church buildings for worship services.

TRAC in fact has issued an official letter, dated May 24, 2020, to direct all TRAC churches to remain closed until the end of June. We also bear in mind that the freedom of mass numbers of worshippers (remember Christmas Day 2019 – without the air-conditioning) will still not be a reality in 2020 bar God's miracle to wipe out Covid-19 from the face of the earth.

As such, we shall continue with Family Worship Services in our homes. We cannot meet physically as Cell Groups until things stabilize pertaining to Covid-19. We must remember that the government has also imposed strict restrictions on the Muslim community's Hari Raya celebrations in 2020 – all in the cause of keeping Malaysia safe.

We do hope that family members are actively participating in the set prayers and Scripture reading that are laid out in the Order of Worship in the Resources for Home Worship. Family worship at home is a new experience, and a different one from worship in the main sanctuary.

Please join us for our three days of weekly prayer meetings on Zoom (Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays) at 8:00a.m. in the morning, and 9:00p.m. at night (the link is given under the announcements).

REFLECTION FOR THIS WEEKEND

JOHN WESLEY'S ALDERSGATE EXPERIENCE

Many have experienced a moment when the Spirit of God came upon them in a powerful way. For some, it happened on a retreat as a youth, or a mission trip later in life. Others had an experience during a Sunday morning worship service or a Wednesday night Bible study. Some have felt Christ especially present while praying from the top of a mountain or crying out over the sound of crashing waves while standing on a beach.

Whatever the circumstances, these moments can be life changing. We look back upon them as times of conversion, renewal, and revelation. We may feel called to do something, experience healing and wholeness, or receive peace about a decision.

John Wesley, founder of the Methodist movement, rather famously had a Holy Spirit moment often referred to as his "Aldersgate experience", when his "heart was strangely warmed." (JOE IOVINO)

What's intriguing to me about Wesley is this: the "heart strangely warmed" moment wasn't the beginning of his deep Christian life. He'd grown up in a home with strict religious discipline. Prayers and Bible reading were daily family activities. Worship attendance was compulsory, and more than once per week.

As an adult, Wesley got involved with other young men determined to be holy. They prayed, fasted, studied, and heroically served the poorest of the poor – all while students at Oxford. He went abroad as a missionary for months. He asked

many pastors and believers for counsel. He endured many wrestling and much agony over his efforts to connect deeply with God.

Relationships, and being in situations to hear the experiences of others mattered. Wesley listened to Moravians on board a ship crossing the Atlantic. All those Bible/prayer groups he attended were times for people to share their struggles and successes with God. Wesley's own brother Charles, just 3 days before that Aldersgate evening, underwent "a strange palpitation of heart," eliciting a cry of "I believe! I believe!" and a sense of deep peace.

So after years of all this, then – and only then! – he felt his heart strangely warmed. On May 24, 1738, as was his custom, John Wesley rose before sunrise, read Scripture and prayed. In the afternoon, he popped into a prayer service at St. Paul's, and a short Bible study meeting. Wesley wrote in his journal, "In the evening I went very unwillingly to a society in Aldersgate Street, where one was reading Luther's preface to the Epistle to the Romans. About a quarter before nine, while he was describing the change which God works in the heart through faith in Christ, I felt my heart strangely warmed, I felt I did trust in Christ, Christ alone, for salvation; and an assurance was given me that He had taken away my sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death."

While God can come to us at any time and any place, it is often helpful to prepare our hearts to be receptive to the Holy Spirit stirring within us.

As you and I long to hear from God, it is good to follow the examples of John and Charles Wesley who prayed, studied, and sought the counsel of others. We cannot control when or where God will speak to us – it often seems to happen

unexpectedly – but we can put ourselves in a place where we will be ready to hear when it happens. (JOE IOVINO)

God touched John Wesley at Aldersgate and that is why Wesley “felt” his “heart strangely warmed.” I suspect Wesley was not speaking in metaphorical terms here. He literally felt heat in his chest! He had a supernatural encounter with God. This strange warmth led him to know for sure, at that very moment, that God had surely justified him. It is my prayer that Aldersgate will inspire us to open ourselves up to the possibility of encountering the Holy Spirit in a supernatural way. This is probably what is missing today for most people who call themselves Methodists. While we celebrate Wesley’s Aldersgate experience for its significance to Christian history, may we, just like Wesley and many of the saints who came before and after him, also seek to have our own Aldersgate experience. SCRIPTURE LESSON

Zechariah 4: 1 – 14 (English Standard Version)

A Vision of a Golden Lampstand

4 And the angel who talked with me came again and woke me, like a man who is awakened out of his sleep. ² And he said to me, "What do you see?" I said, "I see, and behold, a lampstand all of gold, with a bowl on the top of it, and seven lamps on it, with seven lips on each of the lamps that are on the top of it. ³ And there are two olive trees by it, one on the right of the bowl and the other on its left." ⁴ And I said to the angel who talked with me, "What are these, my lord?" ⁵ Then the angel who talked with me answered and said to me, "Do you not know what these are?" I said, "No, my lord." ⁶ Then he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of hosts. ⁷ Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain. And he shall bring forward the top stone amid shouts of 'Grace, grace to it!'"

⁸ Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying, ⁹ "The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also complete it. Then you will know that the Lord of hosts has sent me to you. ¹⁰ For whoever has despised the day of small things shall rejoice, and shall see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel.

"These seven are the eyes of the Lord, which range through the whole earth." ¹¹ Then I said to him, "What are these two olive trees on the right and the left of the lampstand?" ¹² And a second time I answered and said to him, "What are these two branches of the olive trees, which are beside the two golden pipes from which the golden oil is poured out?" ¹³ He said to me, "Do you not know what these are?" I said, "No, my lord." ¹⁴ Then he said, "These are the two anointed ones who stand by the Lord of the whole earth."

PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

1. Praise God for John Wesley's Aldersgate experience, when his heart was "strangely warmed" by the Holy Spirit. Pray that we too will seek to have our own Aldersgate experience, and open ourselves up to the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Pray for a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon each of us from God to bring revival to His Church. Pray that the Holy Spirit will make us more sensitive to Him so that we can recognize His leading, and follow Him more closely. Pray that He will empower us to grow in our spiritual lives as much as the early disciples did. Pray that He will strengthen us to follow in Jesus' footsteps so that we can live lives of holiness and sacrifice with courage,. Pray that the Spirit will lead us into new lives of daily victory and resurrection. Pray that He will send us forth gifted and empowered to make a difference in spreading the Good News of God's forgiving love.
2. Pray that we will continue to persevere to grow as disciples of Christ. Praise God that many of our Cell Groups are still able to meet via Zoom during this conditional MCO. Pray that we will encourage and edify one another in our Cell Groups, and also hold each other accountable. Pray that our love for Jesus will grow deeper and stronger through life's good times and hard times, that our love for Him will manifest itself as we seek to do His will and obey His commands, as we express our gratitude and honour to Him through our study of His Word, worship and prayers. Pray that we will love Him with our minds by staying teachable. As our intimacy with the Lord grows and deepens, pray that His love for us will motivate us to love others, and see every day as an opportunity to love those we encounter. Pray that as we grow to be faithful disciples of Jesus, we will choose to invest our lives to disciple others.

3. Praise God for the following ministries that are ongoing during this time of the conditional MCO: praise God for the Worship Ministry that has faithfully produced resources for home worship every weekend. Pray that the Lord will grant wisdom and guidance upon the worship team members as they seek to develop and expand the worship resources so that the worship services will bless and minister to the people, and glorify God. Praise God for the online corporate prayer meetings that meet on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings and nights. Pray that God will strengthen and sustain us in our prayers and intercessions, and that more people will join these corporate prayers. Praise God for the online Adult Bible Class on May 17, 24 & 31, for all the people who participated, and pray that they will be encouraged and edified. Praise God for the members of the Community Services Committee who go out periodically to deliver food items to people in need. Pray for God's hand of protection upon them to keep them safe and healthy, for the process to be smooth, and for journey mercies. Pray that these ministries will help keep our church family connected to the Lord, and to each other.

4. In tough times like now, pray that social media users worldwide would refrain from posting and speculating on situations that would unsettle people and perpetuate fear and anxiety among people, as these half-truths or fake news will only worsen an already bad situation. Pray against a malicious spirit, and that people should be responsible and find out the truth or reasons behind an activity before they put up their posts. Pray that these people will be apprehended by the authorities, and dealt with accordingly. Pray that those who receive news through the social media would ensure that the posts they receive are truthful before they resend them to others. Pray that social media users would choose to post positive

and encouraging news to build up people, instead of spreading lies and half-truths, negativity and gloom.

5. Pray for our nation in the light of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong's address during the Parliamentary sitting on May 18, 2020. Pray that the government and the rakyat will adhere to what the Agong said: that the nation will work towards political stability and sound economic fundamentals which are both important as we continue to fight Covid-19 which has led to a health and economic crisis; that lawmakers will always display maturity in politics, including voicing the needs and aspirations of the people, protecting the rakyat's well-being, and adhering to the principles of justice; that MPs will clean politics and not impinge on issues of race and religion; that MPs will inculcate a culture of political harmony, and avoid doing things that could affect peace in the country, and set a good example to the rakyat by being positive and mature in their actions so as to avoid plunging the country into political uncertainty. Pray that both the politicians and the people will work together in unity towards rebuilding a healthy nation and to fast track the revitalisation and growth of the economy.

6. TRAC made a decision to continue to close TRAC churches in the month of June regardless of the government's decision about reopening religious places that are registered with the government in green zones only. Hence, all TRAC churches will continue with online worship services in the month June, 2020. Pray that we will be patient to wait for the time when church buildings will be open again for worship services albeit under strict conditions. Pray that the Lord will grace all homes with His presence as families come together to worship Him with the online worship services. Praise God that there are pre-believers who also participate in the online worship

services. Pray that the Holy Spirit will touch their hearts, and they will surrender their lives to Christ.

7. Many nations have been battling Covid-19 for months on end, and the world is weary and exhausted, filled with fear and uncertainty for the future. Pray for people who are infected with Covid-19, or in quarantine, that they will feel God's loving comfort and peace, and His power of healing through the care of doctors and nurses. Pray for medical professionals and caregivers who are fighting the coronavirus: as more people are falling sick, these healthcare frontliners are working longer hours with fewer supplies, and with more risk of contracting the coronavirus themselves. Pray that God will renew their energy and sustain them on long shifts, and bring His protection upon them. Pray that He will multiply their supplies so they will have the protective items needed to stay safe on the job. Pray also for business owners and families facing financial stress, and especially migrants and refugees who are unable to provide for their families at this time. As people feel financial strain during this time of uncertainty, pray that God will, somehow, in His own miraculous way, provide for them in their times of need, and bring them comfort and peace.
