The latest news from TRAC is that TRAC has directed all our churches to remain closed in the month of May for worship services regardless of the MCO period. This means that our online services will continue until at least the end of May.

Some encouraging news is that Bishop Dr Ong Hwai Teik (Bishop of the Methodist Church in Malaysia) has given the approval for online Holy Communion to be done only with the Methodist pastors presiding over the elements, online and during the context of the Sunday Worship Service. As such, I urge you to prepare the elements by yourself at your home (grape juice and wafer / bread only) for the Worship Service on May 3, 2020. This privilege is only effective while the church building is closed for worship services.

Finally, this simple resource material is made possible for assisting you to worship God from your home. Please use it for the glory of God.

REFLECTION FOR THIS WEEKEND

ACTIVE FAITH

When my son Karl was just a toddler, I would stand him up on the table and call for him to jump from the table into my arms. Did Karl believe I would catch him? Yes. How did I know he believed? Because he jumped. Suppose he wouldn't jump. "Do you believe I will catch you, Karl?" I might coax, and he may nod yes. But if he never jumps, does he really believe I will catch him? No. Faith is active, not passive. Faith takes a stand. Faith makes a move. Faith speaks up.

There are a lot of Christians who claim to have great faith in God but are spiritually lethargic and don't do anything. Faith without action is not faith; it's dead, meaningless: So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. (James 2:17-18)! If it isn't expressed, it isn't faith. In order to believe God and His Word, we must do what He says. If you don't do what He says, you don't really believe Him. Faith and action are inseparable.

Sadly, one of the common pictures of the church today is of a group of people with an assumed faith but little action. We're thankful that our sins are forgiven and that Jesus is preparing a place in heaven for us, but we're basically cowering in fear and defeat in the world, just hanging on until the rapture. We treat the church as if it's a hospital. We get together to compare wounds, and hold each other's hands, yearning for Jesus to come and take us away.

The church is not a hospital; it's a military outpost under orders to storm the gates of hell. Every believer is on active duty, called to take part in fulfilling the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20). Thankfully, the church has an infirmary where we can minister to the weak and wounded, and that ministry is necessary. But our real purpose is to be change agents in the world, taking a stand, living by faith, and accomplishing something for God. You can say you believe God and His Word. But if you are not actively involved in His plan, are you really a mature believer?

If we are not moving forward by faith and taking ground today, we are only treading water or slipping backward. We need to ask God to nudge us forward.

PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

- 1. Praise God for touching our lives with His love. Pray that He will empower us to touch the lives of others through the love He first gave us, to reach out to people around us in words and deeds of love, especially during this pandemic when many are fearful and anxious. Ask for forgiveness for the times when we have procrastinated because we were too busy with our own concerns, when we were worried that the job was too big, too hard, and too personally demanding. Pray that God will help us see the people He wants us to share His love with – our relatives, friends, neighbours – that He will burden our hearts for these people with His mercy and love. Pray that God will make us disciple makers. Pray that the Lord will grant all His people throughout the world the courage to speak His truth, to pray continually, and to work under the empowering of the Holy Spirit to make this world more like His Kingdom.
- 2. Praise God that "we know that to those who love God, who are called according to His plan, everything that happens fits into a pattern for good." (Romans 8:28). Praise Him that in spite of the inconvenience of the MCO, God is using this time to renew our minds and hearts, and mold our character so that we will be exactly who He wants us to be a reflection of Christ. Pray that we will be pliable clay in the hands of the Master Potter: that we will obey Him, and allow Him to touch every area of our lives, repenting of weaknesses as He brings them to the surface; meditating on His Word, and living it out in our daily lives; learning to

wait on God and praying persistently; recommitting ourselves to Him and to what He is doing in our lives; loving Him for who He is, and not for what He can do for us, or give us; and constantly abiding in Christ, so that we will bear lasting fruit that glorifies Him. Pray that as we surrender to His transforming work in us, He will re-create us in Christ to be the beautiful vessels He intends each of us to be.

3 Pray for the Orang Asli (OA) as they face this MCO. Some of the OAs have hunkered down in their huts in the forest, so as to avoid getting infected by the coronavirus, and they live on jungle produce, but make in-and-out trips to villages to replenish items they need. Most of the others remain in their villages, also depending on rural sustenance, but with access to the kedai runcit for items they need to buy. Pray that during this time, they will learn to rely on God for His protection and provision. Pray that the Lord will provide for their needs, be it physical, mental, emotional, psychological, social or spiritual. Pray for all round safety. and that they will not contract any viruses. Pray for the OA pastors, Pastor Rezo, Pastor Noraini and Pastor Rizal, that they will exercise strong leadership at this time, ministering to the OA people, encouraging them to stay strong in Jesus, and to trust in Him. Pray that the OAs will experience the presence, strength and grace of the Lord, that their faith in Him will deepen and grow, and they will be more excited and passionate about sharing the Gospel with other OAs.

- 4. Pray for those who are suffering during this pandemic:
 - for those who are sick / infected by the virus: pray that they may regain their strength and health through quality medical help to fight the disease. Pray that the comfort of God's healing presence will grant them His peace as they entrust their lives to the health care providers. Pray for God's healing upon them. Pray also for families who have lost loved ones, especially for those who were unable to attend the funerals of loved ones who died from the coronavirus, that God will give solace and comfort to them as they mourn and grieve their loss, and grant them closure.
 - for nursing homes: pray that God will encourage the lonely residents and strengthen the staff members who help them. Pray against any spread of infection, and for God's comfort upon families who are unable to visit their loved ones who are staying in nursing homes during this time of the pandemic.
 - for those financially affected: pray that God will protect them from depression and helplessness as they have lost / on the verge of losing their jobs. Praise God for enabling the government to provide financial packages to them. Pray that God will stir the hearts of those who have the ability to give, that they will help and aid people in want. Pray that during this time of darkness, God's light will displace the darkness, and grant hope and life for the future.
- 5. Pray for divine wisdom for the government as it looks into striking a balance between protecting the *rakyat* from Covid-19 and reducing further economic losses due to the MCO. The PM announced that the country was losing up to RM2.4 billion a day due to the MCO, with a total of RM63 billion in losses so far, and would lose another RM35 billion should economic sectors remain closed for another month. Furthermore, although the global Covid-19 situation is not

expected to end any time soon, the economic outlook of the country cannot be allowed to stagnate any further. As the government has decided that most economic sectors in the country will be allowed to reopen on May 4, 2020 during the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO), pray that the businesses involved will heed the standard operating procedures (SOP) set by the Ministry of Health (MoH), and adhere to social distancing and other guidelines issued by the international trade and industry ministry (MITI) under the movement control order (MCO). As the government is relaxing the MCO for the *rakyat*, pray that the people will not abuse the situation, but will abide by the guidelines and conditions set by the government.

The number of people worldwide who have been infected 6 with the coronavirus has exceeded 3 million, and about 250,000 have died from the disease. Pray that where global fear, uncertainty and anxiety are on the increase due to the pandemic, when many are anxious that they might become ill, when many are anxious about their parents and children, their friends, their jobs and their security, they will turn to God. Pray that as they see how fragile life is, people will call on Jesus in their pain, suffering and worries, and find the rest, comfort, peace and hope that only He can provide. Pray for God's mercy upon the third world countries, that He will contain the spread of infection in the world's most densely populated and poorest cities, and spare these countries that are already burdened with disease and chronic poor health. Pray that the Holy Spirit will inspire Christians in every neighbourhood, community, and city in every nation in the world to intercede on behalf of their nation, repenting of sins and asking for God's forgiveness. Pray that God will use His people as agents of love and compassion to love, give, serve and proclaim the Gospel. Pray that God will draw people to Himself through the saving power of Christ.

7. Pray the following prayer:

- May we who are merely inconvenienced remember those whose lives are at stake.
- May we who have no risk factors remember those most vulnerable.
- May we who have the luxury of working from home remember those who must choose between preserving their health or paying their rent.
- May we who have the flexibility to care for our children remember those children who will go hungry because their parents have no means to put food on the table.
- May we who settle in for quarantine at home remember homeless people who have no homes to return to.
- May we who have savings in the bank remember those who live hand to mouth.
- May we who have eternal life in Christ Jesus remember those who have to face an uncertain future, and the fear of death, and find ways to be the loving embrace of God to them
