Unless God answers our prayers instantaneously and rids this Covid-19 pandemic entirely from our earth, we have to embrace the new norm. Time with God alone should never be affected. It is still up to us to choose: *to do it or not?* Changing our lifestyle to be extra protective against Covid-19 (and a host of other

germs) is also a choice: *to practice it or not?* Embracing these little inconveniences will not only protect us and our families and our nation from the deadly threat of Covid-19, it will prove that “an old dog can indeed learn new tricks” – if it is for the betterment of all.

May God bless you in your endeavours to be obedient to this new normal and the Word of God. Amen

REFLECTION FOR THIS WEEKEND

“IT’S NOT MY LIFE!”

We are a very possessive people: we talk about *my* car, *my* house, *my* clothing, *my* paycheck, even “*my* body – *my* life”. We learn as little children that “you can’t play with those toys because they belong to someone else;” and we “must share our toys with others.” As we grow older, we look forward to the day when we make that final payment and the car (house, property, business, etc.) no longer “belongs” to the bank, but now we “own” it. But this is worldly thinking!

Over and over again God’s Word clearly tells us: “*All the earth is Mine*” (Exodus 19:5); “*The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine,*’ declares the LORD Almighty.” (Haggai 2:8) “*What do you have that you did not receive? If then you received it, why do you boast as if it were not a gift?*” (1 Corinthians 4:7); “*You are not your own, you were bought at a price therefore, honor God with your body.*” (1 Corinthians 6:19-20) We must constantly be reminded that “It’s not *my* body, *my* time, *my* money... *my* anything! – It all belongs to the LORD who gives it to us, to use in His service.

In the Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30), don’t just think of money, but of ALL the VERY generous gifts that our Master, God the Father, has entrusted to us – even more valuable than money: health (mentally and physically), abilities (talents); family and friends, time, etc.: everything that we can’t take with us when we die.

In the parable, when the master returned, the two who had “used their talents” and doubled them heard the wonderful words from the master: “Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things.

Come and share your master's happiness!" But the one who had "buried his talent" heard the HARSHTEST WORDS that will ever be spoken: "You wicked and lazy servant!... Take the talent from him and give it to the one who has the 10 talents... And throw that worthless servant outside into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

This is quite shocking to the world today who would say that this servant "really wasn't that bad" – after all, he wasn't like the prodigal son who squandered his father's money; he wasn't like Ananias and Sapphira who lied to the Holy Spirit; he wasn't like the rich man who "feasted sumptuously" while Lazarus begged at his gate. This servant SIMPLY DID NOTHING!

This servant was "wicked and lazy" because he had great opportunities, but he "buried his talent" – he refused to use the wealth (time, abilities, treasures) entrusted to him by his master. This parable focuses on the worthless servant so that we might honestly ask ourselves: "Is it I, Lord?" And when we are honest, we must answer, "Yes, Lord, many times I do not faithfully use the vast amount of blessings You give me. Although You "own" me, there are times that I do not want You to "possess" me; although You have "purchased and won me" with Your holy, precious blood; I'm not "always at Your service." We "bury" the gracious gifts – using them only selfishly for ourselves rather in service to God and others.

Therefore, *my* life, *my* house, *my* education, *my* bank account, *my* family, friends, health, time, talents, etc. – including and especially *my* faith are all given to me by the Master, entrusted to me to use for the glory of God and serving our neighbor. Jesus purchased and won me from sin, death and the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and His innocent suffering and death; that I might be His own, and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting

righteousness, innocence and blessedness. WHAT A PRIVILEGE TO SERVE in God's Kingdom through our first-fruit offerings, our time and talents, joyfully serving within the church, in our families and communities. And knowing that when our Master, Jesus, returns and settles accounts, it will not be a fearful meeting but as He is NOW empowering and blessing us in our service to Him, He will say, "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your Master's happiness."

May God strengthen and preserve us in our lives of service, using the many talents / gifts that God has entrusted to us in service to our Master, until life everlasting. Amen

Matthew 25:14-30 (New International Version)

The Parable of the Talents

¹⁴ “Again, it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted his property to them. ¹⁵ To one he gave five talents of money, to another two talents, and to another one talent, each according to his ability. PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

1. Thank God that He has given us talents, abilities, gifts, skills, time and finances. Pray that we will remember that all that we are, and have comes from the Lord, to be used to build up His Kingdom. Pray that we will understand that He has called us to be stewards of what He has given to us, and caretakers of all He has entrusted to us. Pray that God will help us develop all our talents, abilities, gifts, skills, and together with our finances, to use them wisely, and share them generously, using them in love and service in His Kingdom. Pray that we will encourage one another, and support one another to use our gifts, time and talents for God's glory, and that our faithful stewardship will bear witness to the love of Christ in our lives.
2. The Covid-19 pandemic affected school pupils in many ways, especially on classroom teaching and learning. The closure of schools since March 18, 2020 when the MCO was implemented has caused a surge in the usage of online platforms as educational tools to ensure student learning is not disrupted. The Ministry of Education has developed and promoted e-learning platforms for teachers and pupils so that teaching and learning could continue. Pray that parents and guardians will be able to assist their children with online lessons, that the children will benefit from e-learning, and also that they will be protected from hackers wanting to expose them to inappropriate content and other security threats. On May 11, 2020, the Education Minister said the ministry would give a 14-day

notice for the schools to reopen, limiting it to Form Five and Form Six students, and schools across the country have started preparations for students to return while waiting for an official announcement. Pray for wisdom for all school authorities to plan their logistics and come up with their own Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) to ensure the safety and health of all school students, e.g. the number of students in each classroom, to ensure that the students keep to strict personal hygiene standards and practice social distancing, etc.

3. Praise God for the Adult Bible Class, TOGETHER IN CHRIST, that was held on Sunday, May 17, 2020, for everyone who attended the online class via the Zoom App. Pray that in spite of the 'new' way of having class, the participants will be encouraged and enriched by the teaching, that they will grow in grace, increase in their understanding of Jesus, and develop a close and intimate relationship with Him. Pray for contrite, teachable, and humble spirits, so they will grow as disciples of Christ as they continue to embark on their discipleship journey with Him. Pray that the indwelling Holy Spirit will guide them and help them to be doers, and not merely hearers of what they learn, so they will learn to walk in spirit and truth that they may mature in their Christian faith. Pray that they will be committed to continue to come for the online classes for the next two Sundays. Pray also for Brother Jesse Teh and Brother Ernest Lin, for God's anointing upon them as they facilitate the classes.

4. The conditional MCO was implemented on May 4, 2020, when various economic and social activities were allowed to open to help boost the economy in the nation. Strict adherence to the Health Ministry's standard operating procedure (SOP) during the conditional MCO is crucial to prevent Covid-19 infection rates from increasing. The Health director-general said that by May 18, 2020, which is 14 days after the conditional MCO has been implemented, it will show if the preventive measures are working. As the onus now is not on the government but on each individual, pray that the rakyat will not become complacent as the number of cases comes down, but will continue to strictly observe social discipline. Pray against the rebellious spirit of those who are flouting all the key principles of Covid-19 prevention that could result in a second wave of Covid-19 outbreak. Pray also for wisdom and integrity for the authorities as they make decisions on gatherings for the up-coming Hari Raya, Pesta Kaamatan (harvest festival celebrated in Sabah) and Hari Gawai Dayak in Sarawak.
5. Praise God that our youths are having online youth meetings every Sunday, and around 20 to 30 of them attend these meetings. Pray for them that they will use this MCO period to stay in touch with God, that they will prioritise studying His Word, connecting with Him in prayer and worship. Pray that God will speak to them in a real way, and they will have the opportunity to choose God, and understand how much He loves them. Pray that they will reciprocate that love, and love Him continually, and take ownership of their growth in God. Pray for youths in general that God will mend any friction between the youths

and their parents, especially during this MCO where fractured relationships could become even more fractured. Pray that parents / guardians will ease up on the nagging, and set aside meaningful time to spend with their teen kids, that God will create divine opportunities for divine parent-teen connection. Pray for mental and emotional health for the youths who are going through a tough time mentally and emotionally, or struggling with loneliness and depression, or even suicidal thoughts, because they are left alone with no frequent interaction with family or friends.

6. At the moment, the focus in Malaysia is still on the Covid-19 pandemic and the economy. However, the political climate is still tense, with State Assemblymen (adun) changing political allegiance and thus having ramifications at State Governmental levels. Pray that the Lord will watch over Malaysia amidst these political changes. Pray for justice to be done in due course. Pray that all of the nation's political leaders, at both State and Federal levels, will focus on, and work together in unity to combat the Covid-19 pandemic, and prevent a second wave of infections occurring; in opening up society, especially in the areas of industries and businesses, the movement and transportation of people; and to navigate Malaysia out of the effects of the pandemic. Above all, pray that democracy in Malaysia will be practiced by all – despite the things that have taken place since the last General Election in 2018.

7. Many nations in the world are still experiencing a high number of daily infections and deaths from the deadly Covid-19. Pray that Almighty God, who has everything is in His sovereign control, will keep this new coronavirus from continuing to spread. Pray that He will inspire and invigorate the research doctors to quickly develop better tests to diagnose the virus, create vaccines to prevent it, and identify protocols to eliminate the disease's spread. Pray that God will grant wisdom to the governments in the nations in the world that as they set policies for the protection of their citizens, they will be guided by truth and empathy. Pray that governments will invest in their healthcare systems to preempt the next pandemic, rather than scrambling to respond when it hits. Pray for people in the poorest nations who do not have access to proper medical care and support that the Lord will provide them with good care or miraculously heal and deliver them. Pray for wisdom and resilience for the global Church, that the Lord will be their strength and guide as they respond to the challenges of the virus facing their communities and churches, and that they will be a vessel of healing, care and comfort in this time of pain.
