Sunday, (March 12) – Pray that we will truly know in our hearts the deep love of our Father. Pray that we will never hesitate to return to God. Pray that God will enable us to know that no matter how far we may have strayed away from Him, His everlasting arms are always waiting to embrace us. Pray that the love of God which God lavishes upon us will give us a sense of confidence to be a child of God. Give thanks to the Lord for this season of Lent whereby we are able to share, fast, pray and abstain in order to draw near to God. Pray that through these spiritual disciplines, God may transform our hearts to be more Christlike.

Monday, (March 13) – Holy Week Preparations - Commit to the Lord all that will take place during the Holy Week. Pray that we will not lose sight of the reason why Jesus died for us in the midst of busy preparations. Commit to the Lord the Easter Drama Preparations. Pray that God's message will be spoken through the drama. Pray also for the Maundy Thursday & Good Friday and as well as the Combined Sunrise Service - may all these services help us to connect with God's deep love for us and He was willing to send His precious Son to die on the cross for us.

Tuesday, (March 14) – Reflecting on Health Minister Dr Zaliha Mustafa's statement that Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya recorded the highest rate of depression and anxiety disorders based on 2022 figures, pray the church to be equipped in ministering to the souls of the broken-spirited, depressed and anxious, by journeying with them thorough healing of comfort, love and joy. Pray for the sick that in His goodness and mercy, God will comfort and preserve them from the temptations of the enemy, give them patience in their suffering, and, in His time, restore them to health, and lead them the rest of their lives in everlasting life, through Jesus Christ. Pray for the lost, backslidden, or nominal Christians in our weekly prayer meetings at church, in our devotional times, and throughout the day.

Wednesday, (Mar 15) – Pray for the Nation : Pray for Datuk Seri Azalina Othman, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Law (Law and Institutional Reform), to deliver key reforms on the political financing bill, parliamentary services bill, Contracts Act 1950, and separation of the attorney general's advisory and prosecutorial functions, in light of the unity government's commitment to delivering on promised legal reforms to make Malaysia more accountable and transparent. Pray for the rakyat to willingly accept and support the government's key reforms in good faith (bona fide). As women have demonstrated their calibre and capacity in broad community reach, pray for a proper training and mentoring system to remove all barriers (primarily gender inequality) to Malaysian women's political empowerment.

Thursday, (Mar 16) – TRAC : The Methodist Church in Malaysia - Commit to the Lord our Bishop, Bishop Dr. T. Jeyakumar as he leads the Methodist Church in Malaysia. Pray that the Lord will continue to pour out His grace and strength upon our Bishop as he shoulders various responsibilities as the Bishop. Pray for good health for him and that he will learn to be dependent upon the Lord daily. Pray also that God will surround our Bishop with people who will be able to encourage him and spur him on. Pray for God's protection to be upon his entire family as well.

Friday, (Mar 17) – In February this year, it has been six years since Pastor Raymond Koh was abducted, and it has been 9 years this month since Malaysia Airlines flight MH370 disappeared mysteriously. Pray for God's continuous comfort and grace to be upon the families. Pray that God will reveal and bring to light everything that is concealed. Pray for God's justice and truth to be prevailed.

Saturday (Mar 18) – Pray for the World: Pray for Greece. Pray that God will guide the authorities to fully investigate the cause of the train crash that happened on February 28, which also sparked outrage and frustration among the public over safety standards on the Greek railway network. Pray for peace and order to be remained in the public, and the investigation will produce the significant improvements in the safety of the railways. Pray for God's comfort and healing to be upon the victims and the families.
