Sunday, (March 26) – Jesus says that **I am the Resurrection and the Life. Pray that we will never be tempted to turn our backs on Jesus when things don't seem to go our way. Pray that we will trust that God knows best.

Monday, (March 27) – **The Methodist Church in Malaysia** - Pray and commit to the Lord the upcoming General Conference Pastors School that will take place from the 11th - 14th of April 2023. About 580 pastors from all Methodist conferences will gather together at Port Dickson Methodist Centre. The theme for the Pastors School is A Renewed Pastor. Pray that our pastors be renewed and refreshed as they come away for these few days for a time of learning and resting. Pray that pastors will use this opportunity to connect with one another across conferences. Pray for a sense of unity in serving the Lord as pastors within the Methodist Churches in Malaysia. Commit also to the Lord the speakers - Mr. Asiri Fernando and Dr. David Doong.

Tuesday, (March 28) – Lord, we give you thanks for the improved covid-19 situation, as countries around the world have steadily moved toward the endemic phase. Lord, we thank you for your protection and mercy in allowing all of your churches around the world to gradually gather in-person for their respective worship services in their churches. Lord teach us to have a grateful heart, to be joyful always, to pray continually and to give thanks in all our circumstances.

We praise God for the 7 mentors who have committed themselves in journeying with these youths. Pray that the Lord will enable these youths to be open to the work of God in their lives. Pray for a transformation that would lead to a deeper passion and desire for the Lord. Pray also for God's protection to be upon them throughout this six week program.

Friday, (Mar 31) – Pray for those who will be baptised on April 2 in our church. Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead them to faith in our Lord Jesus by helping them in understanding who He is, what He has done for us, and who we are in Him. Pray that they will continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus. Pray also for the Adult Bible Class (started on March 26) as well as Read through the Bible (April 2-5).
