Pray for all pastors who are being sent to another church. Pray that these pastors may be able to have closures and move on to their respective new charges. Pray also for all those who are being elected into positions at the TRAC level - pray for God's guidance and wisdom to be upon them and that in all that they do, they will always seek to honor God.

**Friday, (Nov 22):** We praise God that He is sovereign over creation and He provides our needs. We pray that God will be compassionate and prevent any catastrophe from occurring when Malaysia experiences heavy rains during the Northeast Monsoon which usually lasts from November to March. Pray that He would direct the authorities to alert the people of any updates. Pray that He will also keep everyone safe, especially in the states on the east coast of Peninsular Malaysia, west of Sarawak and east of Sabah and all the low-lying areas, and that they will pay attention to the authorities' advice to be directed to remain in the safe place.
