PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



Sunday, (Jan 19): Sovereign God, we give thanks to you for revealing mysteries and hidden things at the proper time to the right people. Lord God, grant us the faith to pray at all times and in every circumstance. Let your Holy Spirit remind us to give thanks for every answer so that you might receive glory and our faith might grow strong. Pray that, like Daniel, we will have the privilege to tell others about the kingdom of God since God has revealed his mystery about his kingdom to us. Pray that we won't be like king Nebuchadnezzar who gave a positive but insufficient response; that we will praise Jesus but refuse to put aside our gods and fully commit to him. Pray as disciples of Christ, we will follow Daniel's example in responding to God's revelation with thankfulness.

Monday, (Jan 20): Church: We commit to the Lord, the 1st LCEC meeting this year that will be held on Jan 25 (Sat). Pray for Rev. Gaurri and the leaders for a deeper intimacy with God and for a greater dependency on God's guidance and wisdom in the midst of busy everyday life and ministry. We also commit small group gatherings, such as cell group meetings and prayer meetings, some of which resume/have resumed this month. Pray that God's presence and guidance are experienced in every meeting.

Tuesday, (Jan 21): Pray for more Christian workers and trained pastors, although there are a healthy number of Bible colleges, seminaries, and church-trained programs, as too few people respond to God's call to serve due to family expectations, a lack of role models, and the belief that years of theological training are required. Pray for godly leaders who are willing to go extra miles to lead their churches by nurturing and enabling members to live godly lives through prayer and evangelism. Pray for unity among Malaysia's Christian Federation, which represents evangelicals, Catholics, and mainline denominations before the government, as they battle socioeconomic evils, injustices, and increasing discrimination against ethnic and religious minorities.

Wednesday, (Jan 22): Pray for the Nation – Pray for wisdom among our leaders and decision-makers managing the country's key economic hub so that they can implement sustainable growth and equitable policies for all communities. Pray for the restoration of ethical leadership and good governance at all levels of government administration as well as for increased openness and accountability in public service. Pray for systemic transformation which includes the tearing down of corrupt practices and the breaking of spiritual strongholds that hinder progress, and replacing them with systems built on integrity and justice.

Thursday, (Jan 23): TRAC: Pray for all our District Superintendents as they go about chairing the various Local Conferences in their respective Districts. Pray for God's wisdom to be upon them as they lead and guide the churches under their District. Pray for the Lord's anointing and enablement to be upon them. Guard their hearts and minds and that they would not neglect time with God in the midst of busyness. Pray for journey mercies as they travel.

Friday, (Jan 24): Pray for the next generation, as they may face pressure and expectation from school, society and family. Pray for healing and protection upon them. Pray that the good news of our Lord Jesus will reach this generation, and that they will find true identity and assurance in Christ alone. Pray for the parents, guardians and the church as a faith community to be role models and faithful witnesses for our Lord Jesus. Pray for the students who are taking SPM examinations until February. Pray for good preparation, rest, health and concentration for the examinations.

Saturday, (Jan 25): Pray for the World: It is reported that Israel and Hamas have agreed a Gaza ceasefire and hostage release deal. Thanks be to God for the long painstaking negotiations for this. Pray for God's protection, and nothing will prevent the ongoing discussion and implementation of the deals. Pray that all the remaining hostages from both sides, as well as the people who have been displaced, will be able to safely return to their families at home. Pray that much-needed humanitarian aid will be delivered to the needy as soon as possible. Pray for God's healing and restoration on the lands and people's lives. Pray for peace and harmony to be established.
