Sunday, (Mar 16): Thank you merciful Lord, for reassuring us in Daniel chapter 8 that although we seek answers when we are suffering, we often receive Your gracious presence with us. Pray for those in your group, your family, your neighbourhood, and our church community, who are currently going through a period of suffering. Pray for relief from their hardship, and pray for them to know that God is near as they endure. Pray that we would be the kind of disciple who would trust God even when we don't have all the answers. Pray that as we grow closer to You throughout this Lenten season, our faith will be strengthened, and we will give thanks to Him for fulfilling all of His promises for the future.

Monday, (Mar 17): Church: Pray that we will intentionally spend some quiet time with the Lord during this Lent season, acknowledging His presence and work in our daily lives. May He renew our love for Him, as we reflect upon the depths of His love and grace. Pray for Sunday School outing on March 22. Pray for a great time and bonding with one another, and that they will continue to attend Sunday School following the event. Pray for God's protection upon all who join the outing.

Tuesday, (Mar 18): Pray for the church and Christians to remain strong, focusing on perseverance, resilience, and reliance on God's strength as they face challenges and uncertainties of this life in the face of adversity as portrayed in the vision of Daniel 8. Pray for God's grace and discernment of truth so that the church can discern the truth and remain vigilant against deception and to trust in His unwavering power and love. Pray that the church will be a light in the darkness, a beacon of hope, and a testament to God's grace by completely depending upon Him for guidance, wisdom, and protection.

Wednesday, (Mar 19): Pray for the Nation – Pray that God will have mercy on our nation that its rulers, leaders, and people will repent from their sins and turn to Him, asking for His forgiveness and allowing His justice, mercy, and righteousness triumph over judgment. Thursday, (Mar 20): TRAC: Lent & Holy Week - Commit to the Lord all TRAC Churches as we observe Lent together. Pray for a spiritual renewal to take place in our churches this Lent season. Pray for God's love and the resurrection power radiate in and through our TRAC Churches. Pray that as God's word is being preached and proclaimed - it may take root in the hearts of our people. Pray for our people to have a deeper hunger for righteousness. As we reflect on the life of our Lord Jesus, may we grow to imitate Him in our daily life.

Pray that we will be also sensitive to His guidance to bless and share with those who are in need.

Saturday, (Mar 22): Pray for the World: Pray for God's comfort upon the family of the victims of the recent train hijacking by militants. Pray for healing upon those who witnessed the traumatic incident. Pray for peace and safety in the nation, and for wisdom and strength upon the authorities to manage the difficult issues in a peaceful manner so that harmony will be fostered in the country and in its relationship with surrounding countries. Pray for God's protection upon our brothers and sisters in Christ in the land. Pray that He will provide and strengthen them, as well as encourage them with His presence and Word. Pray that His Spirit will work in the land to open doors for the gospel to reach a large number of people.
