PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Mar 23)</u>: Pray for our church and nation, confessing our sins and pleading with God for mercy—not for our worthiness, but for His glory—as well as for healing, restoration and a renewed focus on His word. Pray that we emulate Daniel's prayer which starts with humility, acknowledging our constant dependence on God and approaching Him in a contrite, fasting, and mourning manner rather than with entitlement. Pray that we will be humbled to realise that our prayers must always be in line with God's purposes rather than just our own as we learn from Daniel's ultimate plea that is not just for the benefit of the people but also for the glory of God's name.

Monday, (Mar 24): Church: Pray for the Youth camp that takes place from March 29 to April 1. We thank God for this opportunity and His provision. Pray for God's protection and good weather. Pray that the He will bless and guide the speaker, Pastor Peter Simon Ganapathy as he shares the word of God. May the Holy Spirit prepare the hearts of participants and minister to them throughout the camp. May they experience the love and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and their faith be strengthened.

<u>Tuesday, (Mar 25)</u>: Pray for the Lord's forgiveness for our ignorance to His Word and for succumbing to the world's temptations and lusts by choosing to live the worldly carnal lives. Pray for the prayer life of our churches to be reignited and the fires of the prayer altar must continue with all perseverance and must never go out (Lev 6:13). Pray that our gracious God will hear our cries, heal our land and spur our churches in Malaysia to rise in obedience and submission to do His will so that the love of God will be displayed in us.

<u>Wednesday, (Mar 26)</u>: Pray for the Nation – Pray for the Malaysian Anti-Corruption (MACC) to combat corruption in our country, which has grown to be a systemic moral virus impeding the country's development and plundering its wealth. Pray for our country's mental health situation is dire; according to the 2023 National Health and Morbidity Survey, one million Malaysians aged 16 and older suffer from depression, and the number of younger age groups (aged 16 to 29 years old) had doubled from 2019 to 2023. Pray for our nation's Parliament, which is the legislative body that responsible for fair government operations, policies scrutiny, budgets approval, and public debate on important issues, ensuring the best interests of the nation and its citizens.

<u>Thursday, (Mar 27)</u>: TRAC: Lent & Holy Week - Commit to the Lord all TRAC Churches as we observe Lent together. Pray for a spiritual renewal to take place in our churches this Lent season. Pray for God's love and the resurrection power radiate in and through our TRAC Churches. Pray that as God's word is being preached and proclaimed - it may take root in the hearts of our people. Pray for our people to have a deeper hunger for righteousness. As we reflect on the life of our Lord Jesus, may we grow to imitate Him in our daily life.

<u>Friday, (Mar 28)</u>: Pray unceasingly for family, friends, neighbours or colleagues who have not yet come to know our Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour. May He reveal Himself and soften their hearts so that they would acknowledge Him. May God grant us opportunities and courage to share with them His good news and His love. Pray that we will be sensitive to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and that He will work through them and they will receive our Lord Jesus as their Saviour, living God.

<u>Saturday, (Mar 29)</u>: Pray for the World: Lord Jesus Christ, you are the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. Forgive us for our sins, our wickedness, our ignorance and rebellion against You. Have mercy upon us. Help us to acknowledge our sins, confess before You and turn away from them. May we draw ourselves to You, the light of the World, and follow You as our Lord and Saviour, Almighty God. We ask for the strength in the midst of temptation in the world, and help us to trust in Your grace and love, desiring to live on the path of righteousness.
