Sunday, (Mar 30): Lord, just as Daniel encountered a vision of spiritual warfare, we approach God in humility seeking His strength as we acknowledge unseen battles raging around and within us. Pray for God's strength and guidance in spiritual battles, knowing we can rest in His sovereign care and glory in fulfilling His purposes. Pray for God's boldness and unwavering faith, like Daniel's, to help us stand firm against opposition and spread the gospel globally. Pray that we become prayerful, not prayerless, that our prayers would matter to God in fulfilling His will on this earth.

Monday, (Mar 31): Church: As we have reached the halfway point of this Lent season, we commit every one of us again to the Lord for His guidance and grace, so that we may discern and embrace His will for us with open hearts. May His grace be upon us as He leads us to search our hearts and to repentance. May His love and grace enable us to respond to Him in obedience.

Tuesday, (Apr 1): Pray for spiritual renewal and God's grace to deepen faith, strengthen resolve and grow close to Him through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving as we embrace the Lenten season of spiritual discipline. Pray for the 21-day morning prayer journey that our hearts be open to His presence and our minds to His Words so that we can deepen our love and faith. Pray for Noto-Japan Relief Program and the mission trip that aims to mobilise people to spread Christ's love and salvation to least-reached communities, increasing prayer and mission awareness.

Wednesday, (Apr 2): Pray for the Nation – Pray for our Education Ministry as the education system faces challenges such as community engagement, teacher leadership, and inclusivity, particularly in rural areas. Pray for our Education unions that are advocating for increased public funding for education as part of the “Go Public! Fund Education” campaign as part of the policy reforms, academic integrity, and financial transparency. Pray for the Sarawak government plans to develop affordable housing for the B40 (low income) group in Kuching, emphasizing inclusivity in urban development.

Thursday, (Apr 3): TRAC: Lent & Holy Week - Commit to the Lord all TRAC Churches as we observe Lent together. Pray for a spiritual renewal to take place in our churches this Lent season. Pray for God's love and the resurrection power radiate in and through our TRAC Churches. Pray that as God's word is being preached and proclaimed - it may take root in the hearts of our people. Pray for our people to have a deeper hunger for righteousness. As we reflect on the life of our Lord Jesus, may we grow to imitate Him in our daily life.

Friday, (Apr 4): Pray for missionaries. Pray that God will keep them safe and provide them strength. Pray that He will open doors for equipping, ministry, blessed friendship and partnership. May God provide them with words that communicate effectively with people from other cultures and languages in order to share God's love and good news of our Lord Jesus. May God provide them the opportunities to spend time with other missionaries for mutual encouragement. May God be their source of strength, peace and hope, and may He refresh and grant them rest.

Saturday, (Apr 5): Pray for the World: Pray for the regions marked by wars and conflicts. May God's mercy and intervention be upon them for peace and reconciliation. Pray for those who suffer from violence, injustice and oppression. May the Lord hear their cries and rescue them. Pray for those who are affected by natural disasters like floods, droughts, forest fires, and so on. May God protect them and provide their needs. Pray for the leaders. May God protect their minds and hearts, and guide them with wisdom and discernment.
