PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (May 11)</u>: Heavenly Father, we come before You with grateful hearts, lifting up all mothers everywhere. Just as Elijah stood on Mount Carmel in 1 Kings 18, boldly rusting in Your power and faithfulness, we pray that every mother would experience Your presence, strength, and provision in their lives. Pray for mothers carrying heavy burdens – whether in grief, single parenthood, or facing storms in their lives, like Elijah, their prayers are heard and answered by a compassionate God who never fails. Pray for God's blessing to every mother with wisdom, patience, and joy and their homes be places where His love is known and praised.

Monday, (May 12): Church: We thank God for the opportunity of a short-term mission trip to Noto, Japan, organized by OM, in which some of our church members were able to participate. As this is the last day, pray for God's protection upon each of the participants and their journey home. Pray that God would continue to work among the people of Noto, growing the seeds that have been planted. Pray that this trip provided each participant with a unique way to encounter God, and that He will continue to guide and minister to them afterward.

<u>Tuesday, (May 13)</u>: Pray in humility to commit the body of Christ to God, hoping they will remain watchful, prepared, and steadfast living in these challenging end-times. Pray that God will strengthen the Church to resist temptation, deception, and trials, and to give each believer the wisdom, power and direction of the Holy Spirit as they endeavor to live holy and righteous lives glorifying God. Pray that the Church to be united in love, encouraging one another daily, and growing in faith and understanding, while also surrendering their lives to the sovereign God.

Wednesday, (May 14): Pray for the Nation: Pray for our nation's judiciary to continue upholding the rule of law, maintaining judicial independence, and dispensing fair and just decisions without fear or favor. Pray for level-headedness and wise-acting in decision making process in international trading relationships that our country which is a highly open economy will not be severely affected by the ongoing global trade war. Pray for a fruitful time together as board members come together to pray and discern God's direction in ICM. Pray for each board member to be attentive to the voice and promptings of God. Friday, (May 16): Pray for protection from scammers. Pray for wisdom upon the leaders of both countries, as well as support by international leaders to work and make decisions that will promote peace and unity.
