PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



Sunday, (Aug 24): Pray that each of us will always be discerning and wise in accordance with God's measures, and that we will all possess the wisdom and understanding that come from God rather than from the world. Pray against bitterness, pride, and selfish ambition, asking God's protection from disorder and prideful striving in in our hearts, families, and church. Pray for purity, peace, gentleness, openness to reason, mercy, and good fruits reflecting God's holiness and resulting in righteousness in our lives and ministries.
