PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Aug 31)</u>: Father, we are so thankful that You have given us the wisdom and truth of the Holy Spirit, through Your Son, Jesus. Pray for the Holy Spirit to guide, comfort, and empower us into all truth, so that we will not be stumbled or discouraged by hardships, knowing God is always with us. Pray the Holy Spirit will fill our hearts with God's presence and open our ears to hear His voice, our eyes to see His truth, and our hearts to receive His guidance. Pray that we will rest in the assurance of God's sovereign plan, grow in grace and wisdom by the revelation of the Spirit, and honor God in all we do.

<u>Monday, (Sept 1)</u>: Church - We thank God for our church Missions & Evangelism ministry that are reaching out to people in different regions in Malaysia as well as other countries in partnership with individuals and organisations. We thank God for His faithfulness in His provision. Pray for protection, wisdom, boldness, peace and joy to be with the teams, and may He guide them to fruitful interactions with those they minister to. Pray that God will soften the hearts of people who hear the gospels that they will welcome Jesus into their lives as their personal Saviour and a living God.

<u>Thursday, (Sept 4)</u>: TRAC: Board of Ministry - We give thanks to God for pastors who have applied in to be ordained as Local Deacons and Elders and as well as those who have applied in to come in as Probationary Pastors. We commit the interview sessions with them that will take place on 12th of Sept 2025. Pray for good interview sessions to take place. Pray for God's wisdom to be upon Rev. Paul Christie as he chairs these session as the BOM Chairman. Pray also for all BOM Members to be attentive to the Lord's voice as we listen to those who are coming in. Pray for journey mercies for those who would travel in for the interviews.
