PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Sept 14)</u>: Pray for humility to confess our sins, reject pride, selfish desires, and worldly passions, and to walk dependently solely on God's grace, not personal wisdom or strength. Pray for grace to completely submit to God's authority in all area of our lives, and ask strength to resist the devil and maintain steadfast faith.
