PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



Sunday, (Sept 21): Pray that we will heed James' warning that greed breeds misery and guard our hearts from the love of money. May the Lord, teach us to store up our riches in heaven, where they will not be destroyed by moth and rust. Pray that our hearts be softened to live justly and generously, honoring the dignity of everyone, especially the poor, because God will witness every act of greed and injustice committed against the weak. Pray that God will open our eyes to the reality that greed is self-deceiving - the false security of wealth, comfort, and self-indulgence that blinds us to the needs of others and to God's coming judgment.

Monday, (Sept 22): Church – We thank God for the ministries that He has entrusted to us in Klang Wesley. We acknowledge and thank God for His provision, guidance, and His work among us. We give all praise and honour to Him. Pray for God's empowerment, wisdom, and guidance for the leader of every ministry. Pray for the unity in the team that they will pursue God's will and serve effectively in Him to meet the needs of the church as well as of the community.
