**Monday, (Oct 6): Church** – As we designate October as Missions month, we pray for God's guidance to pursue His heart and vision within our church, our communities, and our nation. We ask God for boldness and wisdom, and may we be filled with His Spirit to carry out His mission. May all barriers of doubt, fear, and scepticism be removed, and His truth and hope may be embraced in the hearts of people. May God empower His Church to serve Him and advance His Kingdom.

**Tuesday, (Oct 7):** Pray that God would raise a new generation that seeks God, embodies holiness, and rejects false idols, as guided by Psalm 24:4-6.
