## PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



**Sunday, (Oct 12):** Pray that as God's vessels of love, instruments of grace and agents of compassion, we should endeavor to imitate the acts of compassion that Jesus demonstrated throughout his life and ministry. Pray for the commitment to follow Jesus as an active proclaimer of hope, reconciliation, redemption, and transformation through His peace and the Holy Spirit's empowerment. Pray that we are to be incarnational like Jesus, to be where the people are, to perform acts of compassion, proclaim the gospel, and demonstrate God's power.

**Monday, (Oct 13): Church** – We commit to the Lord, Adult Baptism & Membership Class. We thank God for the candidates who have expressed their desire for baptism and/or membership. May God bless and prepare the hearts and minds of the candidates, enabling them to attend every class with joy and encouragement that comes from Him. Pray for all preparations to go on well and smoothly. Pray for all registrations to come in on time. This year is a special year for the conference as we celebrate and remember God's faithfulness upon TRAC for 50 years. Pray for good participation from our churches for the Gala Night Dinner on the 22nd of November. The conference and the celebration will be held at KSL Esplanade Hotel, Klang.

**Friday, (Oct 17):** Pray for the people around us who are expressing life stress. Pray that they will turn to Jesus, as He has invited every one of us. May they surrender their anxieties, concerns and struggles to the guidance of Jesus, trusting that He will carry them through.
