**Sunday, (Oct 26):** As we are entering the final week of the month of Mission, pray for the church to embrace a deep commitment to raising up a strong and impactful Orang Asal church in the heart of the nation. Pray for spiritual breakthrough, the readiness of hearts for transformation through God's living word, and for unity in fasting and prayer among the church to see personal and national spiritual growth. Praying for a heart for mission involves persistent prayer, fasting, and obedience, aiming to bring God's wonders among His people through a spiritually led church community.

**Monday, (Oct 27): Church** – With reports indicating a noticeable increase in influenza cases across the country, we pray for God's protection for ourselves in church and in our communities, especially for the vulnerable, including young children, the elderly, individuals with chronic illnesses, pregnant women, and healthcare workers. Pray that awareness in the community will increase and that vaccinations will be readily available. Pray for healing and complete recovery for those who are infected with influenza.

**Tuesday, (Oct 28):** Pray for a renewed mission vision for Malaysian churches, focusing on God's Great Commission and rediscovering their purpose to proclaim Christ and make disciples globally, beginning right here in our land. Pray for God's protection, provision, and support for mission workers and pastors, ensuring their spiritual, emotional, and financial stability, resulting in lasting fruit for God's kingdom. Pray for marginalized communities, including rural, indigenous, migrant, and urban poor, and that God will raise a new generation of believers with a mission-oriented heart.

**Wednesday, (Oct 29): Pray for the Nation:** Pray for our country as the host for the ASEAN Summit from October 26-28 to be a beacon of hospitality, diplomacy and unity serving as a platform for building bridges promoting understanding, cooperation and compassion among nations from the United States, Russia, Brazil, South Africa and across Southeast Asia. Pray for a peaceful Sabah State election on November 29, free from manipulation, corruption and division, and for leaders who prioritize people's welfare over personal gain. Pray for wisdom and courage as the Ministry of Education investigates and conducts post-mortems to uncover root causes of classroom issues, implementing effective measures to restore the schools as safe places again for learning, growth, and friendship.

**Thursday, (Oct 30): TRAC - 50th TRAC Session :** We commit to the Lord the smooth running of the 50th TRAC Session. Pray for the Episcopal sharing by Bishop Dr. T. Jeyakumar to be engaging and edifying. Pray for our conference President, Rev. Joshua Khong as he delivers his Presidential address and preaches at the Opening Service. Pray that as we go through the business sessions and reports, we will recognize the work of God in our midst. Commit to the Lord the Ordination Service, pray that it will be a service whereby pastors remember their calling and their ordination. Pray also for the appointments of DSs, Pastors and others that those who are appointed may with the help and grace of God carried out the responsibilities entrusted to us.

**Friday, (Oct 31):** Pray for protection upon us, particularly young people, from the harms of social media. May God protect us by guarding our hearts and minds against comparison, negativity, hatred, and temptation. May He help us to find our true worth in the Lord and use technology in a way that is good and beneficial. May God help us to develop resilience to resist harmful influence from social media.

**Saturday, (Nov 1): Pray for the World** – Pray that the good news of our Lord Jesus will enter unreached people groups in the world. Pray that God will break down cultural and spiritual barriers and soften the hearts of people. Pray that the Holy Spirit will convict their hearts and open their spiritual eyes to the Truth. We also pray for missionaries, local believers and organisations who work among unreached people groups. May God protect them and enable them to persevere through challenges. May He also equip them with wisdom to communicate with people effectively and assist them with cultural understanding and spiritual discernment.
