Pray for a deep faith that makes prayer effective and powerful, as exemplified by Elijah's righteous and fervent prayers that brought about significant results.

**Monday, (Nov 3): Church** – We thank God for His presence and guidance during the leaders' meeting that took place on Oct. 24th and 25th. We also come before God in gratitude and praises for His goodness and faithfulness, as we commemorate our church's 124th anniversary. May God continue to reveal His plans for the church and empower every member to fulfil His will for both the church and the community. May His name be exalted in the community that many more people may be drawn to have faith in Him.

**Tuesday, (Nov 4):** Pray for safety and tenacity of persecuted Christians in North Korea, Afghanistan, Somalia, Libya and Pakistan that they may lead others to the God of the Bible and find hope amidst violence. Pray for God's protection over those who have been driven from their homes, and may He provide them food, water, and a safe place to stay. Pray for God's protection from violence, diseases, and malnutrition. Pray for the children that they will find a safe place to learn and grow for their future.
