**Sunday, (Nov 9):** We express gratitude for the privilege of being co-workers with God and for the way how God gathers, grows, and builds His people for His glory. Pray for ongoing guidance and strength for pastors, leaders, and members to ensure their labor is fruitful and grounded in the foundation of Christ. Pray for humility and trust in God's presence to overcome feelings of inadequacy in daunting tasks, trusting that His companionship is sufficient. Pray for faith and perseverance, trusting that God's promise ensures ultimate victory, even in uncertain times.

**Monday, (Nov 10): Church** – We come before the Lord with hearts overflowing with thankfulness for His unwavering faithfulness. We thank God that His steadfast love and mercies are new every morning, and He will continue to guide us to partnership with His work to make our Lord Jesus known in the communities. We commit ourselves to remain faithful to Him in our thoughts, words, and deeds. We give all glory, honour and praise to Him.

**Tuesday, (Nov 11):** Pray for global unity and love among churches, encouraging believers and leaders to support one another, grow in faith, and collaborate effectively in spreading the gospel across diverse cultures and nations. Pray for nations in conflict such as Israel, Gaza, Ukraine, Yemen, Syria, Ethiopia, and parts of Africa continent for God's peace to prevail and for healing among victims of war and violence. Pray for protection and resilience for churches facing opposition, political instability, or restrictions on worship, that they remain steadfast beacons of hope and faith in their communities.

**Wednesday, (Nov 12): Pray for the Nation:** We express gratitude for the High Court's ruling that mandates compensation for Pastor Raymond Koh's family, marking a significant step towards justice and accountability in his abduction case. Pray for justice and protection for victims of wrongful abduction, seeking that all concealed cases be illuminated and addressed with integrity and transparency by the authorities in power. Pray for divine intervention to eliminate corruption in the civil service, uprooting bribery, dishonesty, and abuse of power that obstruct justice and good governance. Pray for a culture shift in our nation towards integrity and accountability, emphasizing the MACC's role in promoting justice and reform.

**Thursday, (Nov 13): TRAC - 50th TRAC Session :** We commit to the Lord the smooth running of the 50th TRAC Session. Pray for the Episcopal sharing by Bishop Dr. T. Jeyakumar to be engaging and edifying. Pray for our conference President, Rev. Joshua Khong as he delivers his Presidential address and preaches at the Opening Service. Pray that as we go through the business sessions and reports, we will recognize the work of God in our midst. Commit to the Lord the Ordination Service, pray that it will be a service whereby pastors remember their calling and their ordination. Pray also for the appointments of DSs, Pastors and others that those who are appointed may with the help and grace of God carried out the responsibilities entrusted to us.

**Friday, (Nov 14):** We thank God for His protection daily. As many of us commute in cars or on motorcycles every day, we pray for protection from all dangers, distractions, and mechanical breakdowns to ensure a safe trip to every location. May God's presence be with us and grant us wisdom and patience. We also pray for guidance and protection for those in authority and for those who work to uphold order and enforce laws on our roads and highways.

**Saturday, (Nov 15): Pray for the World** – Prayer for an end to Transnational crime, as it progresses with emerging unlawful activities such as cybercrime and identity-related crime in addition to drug trafficking and human smuggling. Pray for the victims of these crimes that God will bring them to safety, heal their wounds, restore their dignity, and sustain them with hope in Him. Pray for the safety of the vulnerable population so that they will remain uninfluenced by networks seeking to recruit them for illegal activities. Pray for wisdom and collaboration among international authorities for investigation and law enforcement.
