PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Nov 16)</u>: Pray for those who feel rejected by family, church, or society due to *cancel culture* (judgment without grace) to find hope in God's love and acceptance. Pray that today's Luke passage will teach us to seek God's wisdom and grace so that we can see like Jesus, who sees beyond the labels, and that our Lord does not define us by our past. Pray for the rejected, seeking reassurance and hope through the Lord's forgiveness and restoration because rejection is not the end of the story.

Monday, (Nov 17): Church – Pray for the ongoing our church baptism & membership class. Thanks be to God for the 6 candidates taking part in the class. Pray that the Holy Spirit will prepare their hearts and minds, guiding them to understanding and conviction so that they will take a step of faith to proclaim Jesus as their only one true God and living Saviour, and to make a commitment to be His follower. Pray that they will be embraced by the church as a family of Christ and continue to grow together in the Lord.

<u>Tuesday, (Nov 18)</u>: Pray for renewed passion for God's presence and Word, and a fresh commitment to mission in local congregations through the fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Pray for the physical health, safety, stamina, and protection of missionaries from loneliness, discouragement, and depression during stressful conditions. Pray for the fervour and perseverance of a prayer life that prioritises bridging denominational gaps and fostering unity among believers.

<u>Wednesday, (Nov 19)</u>: Pray for the Nation: Pray for our leaders to keep the nation united in a way that prioritizes the social and well-being of the people and promotes good governance and justice. Pray for greater harmony, mutual respect, and acceptance among diverse races, religions, and backgrounds, as well as for the nation's continued peace and security. Pray for economic prosperity and a reduction in poverty, especially for indigenous communities in rural areas.

Thursday, (Nov 20): TRAC - 50th TRAC Session: We commit to the Lord the smooth running of the 50th TRAC Session. Pray for the Episcopal sharing by Bishop Dr. T. Jeyakumar to be engaging and edifying. Pray for our conference President, Rev. Joshua Khong as he delivers his Presidential address and preaches at the Opening Service. Pray that as we go through the business sessions and reports, we will recognize the work of God in our midst. Commit to the Lord the Ordination Service, pray that it will be a service whereby pastors remember their calling and their ordination. Pray also for the appointments of DSs, Pastors and others that those who are appointed may with the help and grace of God carried out the responsibilities entrusted to us.

<u>Friday, (Nov 21)</u>: We thank God for His protection daily. As many of us commute in cars or on motorcycles every day, we pray for protection from all dangers, distractions, and mechanical breakdowns to ensure a safe trip to every location. May God's presence be with us and grant us wisdom and patience. We also pray for guidance and protection for those in authority and for those who work to uphold order and enforce laws on our roads and highways.

<u>Saturday</u>, (Nov 22): Pray for the World – Prayer for peace between Thailand and Cambodia. Pray for wisdom for the leaders so that they will choose dialogue over violence, and achieve enduring peace. Pray for the safety and protection of all people, particularly those residing near the border. Pray for healing for those who have been affected, and that those who have been displaced will be able to return to their homes.
