Sunday, (Dec 28): Pray that our hearts will be fertile soil, prepared to hear, receive, comprehend, and respond to God's Word in faith. Pray for spiritual maturity and depth in each and every one of us rather than shallow faith and ask God to strengthen our faith in the face of adversity, persecution, or pressure. Pray that God's Word will produce enduring fruit in our lives—thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold—and that our lives will be characterized by faithful witness, good deeds, and Christlike character.

Monday, (Dec 29): Church – We commit to the Lord, our December 31 events. Pray for the leaders and every person to act with wisdom and compassion. May He bring unity to the afflicted nations and heal the sufferings. May His light of salvation shine on every heart, transforming hatred into His infinite love. May God empower us to be agents of peace and reconciliation.
