PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

Prayer Points

1. Pray that God will raise up believers with the spirit of Caleb – people of conviction, perseverance and unwavering faith. Pray that God will strengthen those who have been serving for many years. Pray that they will not lose heart. Pray that God will reward their labour with renewed joy and spiritual fruitfulness.
2. **Young believers** – We pray for God to encourage our young believers to remain faithful in a changing world. Protect them from the urge to compromise and spiritual complacency. For those who are experiencing wilderness, pray for patience and remind them Lord of your perfect timing. Pray that God will bless us with courage for every battle, faith for every challenge and hope for every tomorrow.
3. **Malaysia Prayer Convention 2026** – Pray for the Lord's presence to fill the entire convention. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to anoint all the speakers are involved in the convention.
