PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Feb 26)</u> – In this season of Lent, may we as God's people, reflect on the life, death, and resurrection of Christ so that we will model him in trusting and waiting for his Father's provision and timing. Pray that we will follow the footsteps of Christ by resisting temptations to put God to the test and force his hand to act in our favor. Pray that we will model Christ's faithfulness in full submission to the Father's will and his way by obedience, humility, and being willing to suffer for his sake and for the sake of his kingdom.

<u>Monday, (Feb 27)</u> – Cell Group Ministry: Pray for CGs to grow together in the Lord. Pray for God's wisdom and guidance to be upon all CG Leaders as they lead their respective CGs. Pray that members will be able to connect with God and with one another as they meet together. Pray that through the CG ministry, we may be able to encourage and spur one another on in our walk with God. Pray that members would not neglect coming together to meet.

<u>Tuesday, (Feb 28)</u> – Pray that Christ churches will continue to grow in knowledge and understanding so that they can serve God's kingdom and that their sincere love for Christ and his people will continue to overflow. Pray for the congregation members who are presently experiencing pain and suffering, whether due to a physical ailment, emotional distress, or mental illness, so that they may turn to Christ for solace and strength that their faith in Christ will be strengthened. Pray for all the caregivers who are heavy laden that they will find strength, joy, and restoration of their soul, body, and mind in the Lord rather than becoming worn out, depressed, or burnt out.

<u>Wednesday, (Mar 1)</u> – <u>Pray for the Nation</u>: Pray for the current Parliament sitting which runs from February 13 to March 30, the previous strategic and administrative issues will receive prompt attention, particularly with regard to focusing and rebuilding the economy and reducing the burgeoning national debt. Pray that justice will be served in the upcoming court proceedings and rulings involving high-profile corruption cases from the political parties. Pray for mission schools to rediscover their original ethos and traditions so that they can play their pro-active and effective role in blessing our nation by instilling values like racial harmony, kindness, and justice.

<u>Thursday, (Mar 2)</u> – <u>TRAC</u>: Pastors Book Fellowship - A group of pastors come together once a month for a book fellowship. The book that we are reading is The Deeper Journey. We come together to talk and discuss how we may apply the lessons we learn from our reading into our own life and as well as into the lives of our churches. Pray that through this fellowship, pastors may grow deeper in their walk with God. Pray also that through this fellowship, pastors may learns and apply all that they have learnt into the live and ministry of the church. Pray that fellow pastors may also be able to help one another and be there for one another.

<u>Friday, (Mar 3)</u> – Pray for the CCM World Day of Prayer that is held tomorrow March 4th at CCM Ecumenical Centre PJ. Pray for God's blessings and guidance to be upon the speakers and facilitators. Pray for the participants that God will prepare their hearts and protect their journey. Pray for God's presence throughout the preparation and meeting itself that all who join will be blessed and ministered by Him for His glory.

<u>Saturday (Mar 4)</u> – <u>Pray for the World</u>: Pray for repentance of the world that we would turn away from wickedness, and turn to God for His forgiveness and choose to walk in His ways. Pray for peace and justice to be restored in areas where there are conflicts, violence and injustice. Continue to pray for Russia and Ukraine as it is almost one year since their conflict saw an escalation with Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February last year. Pray also for countries in Asia that peace and justice would prevail in areas where there are political tensions or violence. Pray for God's protection and deliverance upon many who are suffering.
