PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Apr 30)</u> – Marriage is for life because it is God-ordained covenant between a man and a woman. And in Matthew 19:6 and Mark 10:9, Jesus emphasizes the importance of marriage as a lifelong commitment (until death do us part). Pray that we will constantly reexamine our desire to embrace holiness in radical obedience to Jesus' hard teaching to eliminate lustful intent in our hearts, which has resulted in adultery and divorce. Pray that we will not take sexual immorality lightly and will always be on guard, like Joseph, to take radical action to avoid any sexual temptations, either personally or as a Church. Pray that we will preserve, protect, and strengthen our marriage relationships because marriage is a covenant relationship between a man and a woman that God has instituted.

Monday, (May 1) – The Alpha Parenting Course - Pray and commit to the Lord the currently ongoing Alpha Parenting Course. Give thanks to the Lord for each participant of the course.
