PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

<u>Sunday, (May 14)</u> – Home is where discipleship begins. Pray for each home represented here in Klang Wesley. Pray that we will learn to imitate the home of Timothy who grew in the Lord through the influence of his mother and grandmother (2 Tim 1: 1-5). Pray that parents will take it upon themselves to teach children scriptures so that they may grow up to make a wise decision regarding their faith in God. Pray for the Word of God to be a priority in each family.

<u>Monday, (May 15)</u> – Commit to the Lord all the preparation for the upcoming Klang Wesley Youth Camp. Commit to the Lord as well the fund raising efforts that will be held on May 21st for this very purpose. Pray that this forum would be a good platform to enquire and know about what is being done at the conference level pertaining to the three ministries. Pray for the moderator (Rev. Lim Chaw Leong) that he would be able to moderate the forum well.

Friday, **(May 19)** – May 19 (Fri.) Even while the pandemic's emergency status may have ended, the covid virus has not yet been eliminated; in fact, this month has seen an upsurge in the number of cases. Pray for God's wisdom upon the authorities, as they periodically examine the covid-19 prevention and control measures. Pray that we will continue to stay vigilant with the necessary precaution.
