# PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (June 4)</u> – Pray that our trust in Jesus will deepen as we continue to surrender the well-being our lives unto the Lord. <u>Monday, (June 5)</u> – TRAC: Pray for Living Hope Methodist Church, Bukit Rimau as they work towards organizing their fund raising dinner in July.
