Sunday, (June 11) – Pray that we do not act as judges in our relationships with others by scrutinising on minor issues while ignoring to deal with our own baggage issues. Pray that Jesus' admonitions in verses 3-5 will lead us to deeper self-examination and confession of our sins as the body of Christ grows in holiness with fewer planks and specks around us. Pray that our persistence in asking, seeking, and knocking on the door of our answering Father in heaven will deepen our trust and faith in Him, knowing that He knows how to give good gifts to His children. Pray that by God's might and grace, He will enable us to embody Jesus' golden rule in our lives, homes, communities, and workplaces.
