THE FELLOWSHIP OF THE LEAST COINS VISION & MISSION

The Fellowship of the Least Coin has flourished as a global ecumenical woman's prayer movement. The key to the movement's success is its simplicity. Individuals or groups may join by committing to pray for peace, justice and reconciliation among families and communities, and worldwide. Each time a woman prays, she sets aside the least coin of her local currency as a symbol of the prayer. Woman's national groups collected the coins and sent them to the

central FLC Fund c/o World Council of Churches in Geneva, Switzerland.

The prayers offered and the least coins collected support projects for women and children around the world.

The FLC Prayer movement is simple, yet significant and unique. It brings Christian women together in a fellowship of prayer, without any discrimination of race, nationality, colour, culture of the denomination.
