PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



Sunday, (Nov 5) – Pray for a deeper awareness of who we are as we stand in the presence of God. Pray for humbleness within our hearts as we approach the throne of grace knowing full well of all that Jesus has accomplished for us. Pray that God will remove from our hearts any pride that prevents us from being dependent upon the grace of God. Pray that we will learn to exalt and magnify God for who He is. Pray that God will examine our hearts and lead us to repent of our pride so that we may seek God in humility.

<u>Monday, (Nov 6)</u> – Church Planning Retreat: Commit to the Lord the upcoming Church Planning Retreat that will take place from the 24th - 26th of November. Pray that as both the LCEC and as well as the CG Leaders come together, we may be united in seeking and discerning God's direction for our church. Pray that as leadership come together, we may once again reconnect with God and with one another. Pray for our leaders to be sensitive and attentive to the work of the Holy Spirit in our church and that we may learn to respond to God's invitations to the church.
