PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

<u>Sunday, (Nov 12)</u> – Just like how Zacchaeus responded to Jesus' invitation immediately, pray that we too will desire to respond to Jesus' invitation immediately. Pray that our hearts will not be harden when Jesus calls out to us. Pray also that as Jesus reaches out to those who are looked upon as unworthy, we too will learn to reach out to all people and would never deem anyone unworthy. Jesus came to seek and save the lost - pray that we will share and proclaim and be witnesses of Jesus wherever God has placed us so that many will come to know and experience the saving knowledge of Jesus.

<u>Monday, (Nov 13)</u> – Church Planning Retreat: Commit to the Lord the upcoming Church Planning Retreat that will take place from the 24th - 26th of November. Pray that as both the LCEC as well as the CG Leaders come together, we may be united in seeking and discerning God's direction for our church. Pray that as leadership come together, we may once again reconnect with God and with one another.
