Sunday, (Nov 26) – Let us pause and give thanks and praise to God for all that Jesus has done for us. It is indeed by faith that we are saved and born into a new creation. Pray that we will allow the Holy Spirit to work so deeply in us and that we may be transformed to be more Christlike. Pray also that many others will come to know the saving knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray for more to come to faith in Jesus. Pray that God would give us more and more opportunities in sharing the good news of our Lord Jesus.

Monday, (Nov 27) – Commit to the Lord the upcoming **Kids Camp (VBS)** that will take place from the **9th - 11th of December**. Pray for all preparations leading up to the camp to go on smoothly. Pray for Yvonne as she leads her team in this camp. Pray for God's guidance to be upon all kids and youths who are given various responsibilities in the camp. Pray for unity and the ability to work together as a team for the honor and glory of God. Commit to the Lord as well **Rev. Nicholas Choo** who is the camp speaker. Pray that our children will truly learn to become one with God.

Tuesday, (Nov 28) – Pray for increased vigilance in churches, malls, and public places, as well as for security forces to be on high alert, especially during the upcoming Christmas season, given the rising risk of radicalization and extremism. Pray for warring countries, particularly Ukraine and Russia, and for Israel and Palestine to meet the Prince of Peace, for it is only through Him that meaningful reconciliation will be possible. Pray for the church to be faithful ambassadors of the risen Lord, with clean hands and pure hearts, gracious in speech, diligent in prayer, and quick to obey God's Word.

Wednesday, (Nov 29) – **Pray for the Nation:** Pray for godly wisdom and harmony for rulers, the Prime Minister, and cabinet ministers as a united government to steer the nation forward with integrity and fairness, which has been plagued by decades of harmful politicking based on deep racial and religious polarization. Pray for the healing and restoration of trust and relationships so that all politicians can work together for the nation's peace, progress, and harmony. Pray for long-term political and economic stability, as well as much-needed political and economic reform, including clearer government policies and a faster approval process to attract more foreign investment in the country.

Thursday, (Nov 30) – **TRAC:** We give thanks to the Lord for the recently concluded **48th Session TRAC**. Commit to the Lord all decisions that were made at the conference level. Pray for all pastors who are being sent to another church. Pray that these pastors may be able to have closures and move on to their respective new charges. Commit to the Lord as well the two new District Superintendents (Rev. Teoh Lee Yng & Rev. Gaurri Maniam) that they may settle into their new responsibility well.

Friday, (Dec 1) – Thank God for sustaining His creation and for His faithful provision for us. Pray for God's mercy and protection over everyone from floods especially for those who live in low-lying and flood-prone areas, as we enter the northeast monsoon season, which is expected to bring higher rainfall and even heavy rain in various areas of the nation. May God guide The Malaysian Meteorological Department (MetMalaysia) in their efforts to issue weather warnings and may we be vigilant in heeding advice to make the appropriate preparations for travel and outdoor activities as well as for staying at home.

Saturday (Dec 2) – **Pray for the World:** Pray for peace between North Korea and South Korea and that the military tension will not escalate, as their military accord, which was signed and aimed to reduce the military tension five years ago, was suspended last week. Continue to pray for people and countries affected by the wars and conflicts occurring in other parts of the world. Pray for God's mercy and healing in the lands where forgiveness and reconciliation are needed. Pray that by His grace and His wisdom, He will guide the leaders to pursue peace. Pray for His comfort and protection upon every person who has been suffering.
