PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



Sunday, (Jan 21): According to God's envisioning plan for Klang Wesley Church, that is to love You, Lord, with our whole being (Deuteronomy 6:4-5) and to love Your people (Leviticus 19:18), we pray that our love for You and Your people will come from a commitment and loyalty that is visibly demonstrated by yielding to Your will and showing compassion for others. Pray that we will not be like the scribe who treats God primarily as an object of study rather than an object of worship, whose main interest is solely intellectual and has no desire to deepen the relationship with God.
