Sunday, (Feb 25): *In view of God's mercy and all that God has done for us, let us pray that we will indeed be living sacrifices daily. Pray that God will open our eyes to see how we could be living sacrifices for Him daily. Pray that God will give us a willing spirit and heart to be living sacrifices in our workplace; in our schools; in our neighborhood and in our family. Pray that God will teach to love others as an act of worship unto Him. Pray that God will help us to "die to self" so that we may be living sacrifices for His Kingdom.*

Monday, (Feb 26): Church - Let us pray for all Holy Week Preparations. Commit and surrender to God all the special services that will take place during the Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunrise Service & Easter Sunday Service). Pray that for our hearts to be ready to receive God's Word through these services. Pray that God will once again draw our hearts near to His heart so that we can hear God's heartbeat for us and for people. As we reflect on Jesus death and resurrection, pray that God would increase our gratefulness towards Him and will instill in us a passion to share the Good News of Jesus to others.

Tuesday, (Feb 27): Pray for the Lord to raise up a huge number of laborers in the fields, pastors, evangelists, missionaries, and Christian leaders who have a deep burden and passion to share the gospel of Christ, having the Lord's mindset and great humility of serving and selfless love. Pray for the Christian parents to spend quality time during Lenten season, counseling and nurturing their children in the increasing knowledge of Christ, laying a strong foundation for their future. Pray for the protection of our country's adolescents and young working adults from harmful influences that degrade and destroy their lives, such as drugs, alcohol, pornography, gangsterism, bullying and sexual activity.

Wednesday, (Feb 28): Pray for the Nation – Pray for the M40 and B40 category of poor and needy that our Madani government will prioritise for a long-term sustainable mechanism to provide affordable access to healthcare, education, water, electricity and internet connection to this group as they struggle to keep up with the soaring costs of living, particularly in the urban areas. Pray for divine wisdom to guide our nation's policy makers to swiftly and decisively come out a clear and more effective policy directions and measures for implementing reforms that will eliminate any economic uncertainties that affect the plunging of the ringgit. Pray for Sarawak to be granted fair autonomy over its economic resources so that the Sarawakians can continue the legacy of the late Tun Abdul Taib Mahmud, who has left an indelible mark on the state as a beacon of leadership and development.

Thursday, (Feb 29): Baptism & Membership - *Baptism & Membership Service will take place on the 24th March 2024. Pray for those who would be baptized that as they begin their walk with the Lord, they will grow in their faith and trust in the Lord. Pray for God's covering and protection to be upon them. Pray also for the church that we will learn to come alongside them in this journey of faith. Pray that our new members will find their sense of belonging in the church. Pray for the remaining classes of the Baptism and Membership session.*

Friday, (Mar 1): Pray for many children and teachers who are having a holiday from school, that they will experience God's love and goodness during the time. Pray that they as well as parents and guardians will be able to have the time to rest in the Lord, too. As many schools resume on March 11, pray that children will be excited and prepared to go to school. Pray that they will be able to readjust smoothly to their regular schedule with schools and other activities, and focus well in class. Pray that God will bestow His grace, strength, wisdom and patience upon the teachers, parents and guardians as they guide the children in the right direction.

Saturday (Mar 2): Pray for the World: Pray for Russia and Ukraine, as the world marked the second anniversary of their war last week on February 24. Pray for the war to cease, as the war has brought much death and destruction to both countries, and has also affected the world and its neighbours. Pray for God's wisdom to be upon the world leaders that they will work together toward peace. Pray for God's protection, comfort and healing upon the people on both sides. Pray that the Spirit of our Lord Jesus will work among both leaders and people of both nations, bringing repentance, grace, forgiveness and reconciliation.
