**Sunday, (Mar 3):** Give thanks to God for all that Jesus has done for us. It is indeed through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus that we are given our new identity as children of God. Pray that we will learn to live our daily lives in light of this new identity that Jesus has given to us. Pray that we will learn to "clothe ourselves" with virtues that are consistent with our identity in Jesus. We are people loved by God, therefore pray that we will be able to share the love of God with others as well.

**Monday, (Mar 4): Church -** Let us pray for all Holy Week Preparations. Commit and surrender to God all the special services that will take place during the Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunrise Service & Easter Sunday Service). Pray that for our hearts to be ready to receive God's Word through these services. Pray that God will once again draw our hearts near to His heart so that we can hear God's heartbeat for us and for people. As we reflect on Jesus death and resurrection, pray that God would increase our gratefulness towards Him and will instill in us a passion to share the Good News of Jesus to others.

**Tuesday, (Mar 5):** Pray for the recovery and restoration of the sick, including God's ministers, so that they will encounter healing from the hand of the Lord. Pray for strength for caregivers and for our own "wounded" healer" ministry. Pray that anyone who finds themselves at the crossroads will be reminded by our Lord's promises, "You will find rest for your souls if you stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it (Jer 6:16)." Pray for unity among believers within the church a spirit of love, understanding, and unity to triumph, overcoming divisions and bringing together diverse members in harmony.

**Wednesday, (Mar 6): Pray for the Nation –** Pray for our nation's political stability following Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Ibrahim's stern warning against any parties to oust the national unity government and instead focus their energy on efforts to reform the economy to ensure strong, sustainable growth. Pray for the strengthening of accountability institutions to preserve justice and make them resilient to political influences that aim to erode their integrity. Pray for our country's leaders to be guided by divine wisdom and discernment as they deal with pressing issues including the plunging of the ringgit and ballooning fiscal deficits and the challenging economic environment.

**Thursday, (Mar 7): Baptism & Membership -** Baptism & Membership Service will take place on the 24th March 2024. Pray for those who would be baptized that as they begin their walk with the Lord, they will grow in their faith and trust in the Lord. Pray for God's covering and protection to be upon them. Pray also for the church that we will learn to come alongside them in this journey of faith. Pray that our new members will find their sense of belonging in the church. Pray for the remaining classes of the Baptism and Membership session.

**Friday, (Mar 8):** As Malaysia's hot and dry season began earlier this year due to the El Nino effect, pray that God will grant us wisdom to make some adjustments in our everyday lives, such as reducing the amount of time we spend outside during the day, drinking plenty of water and taking frequent showers. Pray for God's protection upon us, especially the sick, the elderly, young children, expectant mothers and those who are required to work outdoors for long periods of time. Pray also for children as many schools resume next week that they will be able to start school in good health.

**Saturday (Mar 9): Pray for the World:** Pray for the refugees in the world who are forced to flee their home due to political conflict, violence, poverty, famine and other issues. As they travel a great distance to reach their destination, pray that God will watch over them throughout the journey and guide them to a safe shelter. Pray that humanitarian supplies will reach them and they will be provided with physical and emotional support. Pray that God will comfort and heal their hearts, who have experienced unspeakable tragedy and trauma.
