Sunday, (Mar 10): Almighty loving God, help us glorify You with our bodies, thoughts, desires, actions, relationships, and moments of solitude, as Your Spirit is always with us, ensuring we are never alone. We pray for God's help in glorifying Him through our bodies, as the temples of the Holy Spirit, and experiencing His fullness. Pray that our bodies be a living sacrifice that is holy and acceptable to You, and that we may be a worthy witness to Your love and grace. We give thanks to God that Jesus' sacrifice purchased us, paid the price for our transgressions, and freed us from the shackles of sin.

Monday, (Mar 11): Let us pray for all Holy Week Preparations. Commit and surrender to God all the special services that will take place during the Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunrise Service & Easter Sunday Service). Pray for our hearts to be ready to receive God's Word through these services. Pray that God will once again draw our hearts near to His heart so that we can hear God's heartbeat for us and for people. As we reflect on Jesus death and resurrection, pray that God would increase our gratefulness towards Him and will instill in us a passion to share the Good News of Jesus to others.

Tuesday, (Mar 12): Pray for the lost souls, who have not realised that they are on the verge of eternal destruction, that the Lord will reveal to them His eternal salvation. Pray for hearts to love lost souls and grant courage to share God's love and salvation with them, thus fulfilling the Lord's Great Commission. Pray for the influx of prayer-spirit into the churches, that prayer-warriors will arise to stand in the gap, and to establish prayer-towers nationwide.

Wednesday, (Mar 13): Pray for the Nation – Pray for stability and peace in our beloved nation, avoiding unnecessary commotion, disturbances, and misuse of words that can cause friction, division, and hatred (1 Tim 2:1-2). Pray for our politicians and ministers to demonstrate respect, responsibility, and rationality in a diverse society and culture. Pray for wisdom and discernment upon our Madani government in managing financial resources, preventing fiscal deficit ballooning, and addressing corruption to prevent weaker financial position.

Thursday, (Mar 14): Baptism & Membership - Baptism & Membership Service will take place on the 24th March 2024. Pray for those who would be baptized that as they begin their walk with the Lord, they will grow in their faith and trust in the Lord. Pray for God's covering and protection to be upon them. Pray also for the church that we will learn to come alongside them in this journey of faith. Pray that our new members will find their sense of belonging in the church.

Friday, (Mar 15): Pray for the father-son camp that is taking place till Saturday, March 17. Pray for God's protection and the good weather. May God bless them with moments of shared laughter and cherished memories that will bind them closer. Pray that His Spirit works among them that their hearts overflow with compassion and acceptance towards one another. May God also heal and mend any wounds or misunderstandings that have strained their relationship, allowing them to extend grace to each other and embrace forgiveness.

Saturday (Mar 16): Pray for the World: The United Nations has warned that widespread famine in Gaza is "almost inevitable" without action. Pray that God, in His mercy, will hear the cries of the innocent and suffering, particularly the sick, the elderly and children, and protect them from starvation, malnutrition and dehydration. Pray for the doors to be open for the humanitarian aid, such as food, clean water and medical supplies to reach the needy safely.
