PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

<u>Sunday, (Mar 17)</u>: Give thanks to God for giving us salvation through faith in Christ Who has become for us our current, continuous and eternal Sabbath rest. Pray that we will continue to be open to God's ongoing work of transformation in our lives. We praise God for starting a good work in our lives and pray that God will bring it to completion in due time. Pray that our lives will indeed be a living testimony of God's goodness and that we will truly be able to give God all the honor and glory.

Monday, (Mar 18): As we have entered into the Lenten Season pray that God will guide us unto the path that leads to Him. Pray that God would fill our hearts with gratitude, patience, strength and peace as we strive to be more and more like Christ. Pray that during this Lenten season, our hearts will learn to be more and more attentive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Tune our ears to be able to listen to Your voice speaking to us and grant us grace to embrace and accept others by showing them your great love.

<u>Tuesday, (Mar 19)</u>: Pray for all who are sick physically, mentally, emotionally, and spiritually that they will encounter healing from the Lord in restoring them. Pray for refugees, migrants, and foreign students that they will be protected from exploitation and inhumane treatment. <u>Wednesday, (Mar 20)</u>: Pray for the Nation – In line with doctrine of constitutionalism and the separation of powers between the executive and legislature, pray that the draft law to revive the Parliamentary Services Act (PSA) which is imperative in upholding the independence and the autonomy of Parliament, to be tabled in Dewan Rakyat and it will be passed. Pray for parent to exercise discernment and wisdom, following our Minister of Communications' call to parents and guardians to perform digital parenting, which is a way for parents to understand, support, and regulate their children's online behavior through utilising the Parental Control Tools on telco platforms to prevent children under 15 from accessing social media accounts of pornographic content and online crime. Pray that there won't be another round of vegetable price hikes due to a production decline in the agriculture sector and a shortage of foreign workers following government's decision to cancel unused foreign labour quota.

Thursday, (Mar 21): Baptism & Membership - Baptism & Membership Service will take place on the 24th March 2024. Pray for those who would be baptized that as they begin their walk with the Lord, they will grow in their faith and trust in the Lord. Pray for God's covering and protection to be upon them. Pray also for the church that we will learn to come alongside them in this journey of faith. Pray that our new members will find their sense of belonging in the church.

Friday, (Mar 22): As we approach Holy week, we thank God again and again for His endless mercy, boundless forgiveness and unfailing love. We thank God that our sins are not too great to be forgiven by Him, that we are not rejected but are accepted and reconciled back to Him through our Lord Jesus Christ who atoned for our sins on our behalf on the Cross. We thank God that we can turn to Him as our Shepherd and Refuge. May we come before Him daily in repentance and thanksgiving, and offer ourselves as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to Him. May He strengthen us and grant us passion to continuously pray for those who have not put their faith in Him and to share with them about our Lord Jesus.

<u>Saturday (Mar 23)</u>: **Pray for the World:** Pray for Laos. Pray for God's protection upon every church and every Christian, especially the new converts. Pray for His protection upon them from violence and pressure in their community. Pray that God will also grant them wisdom as they are monitored by the authorities. Pray that God will enable them to continue to gather together, and He will strengthen their faith. Pray that God will open doors for more people to know the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ.
