Sunday, (Mar 24): Heavenly Father, what amazing grace, that You should send Your only begotten Son to come to earth as the heavenly Lamb of God, Who takes away the sin of the world. Thank You that You loved the world so much that You chose to send Your Son to die on the Cross so that we might live. Thank You that Your plan of redemption does not exclude anyone, Jew or Gentile, and all who call on the name of the Lord in faith will be saved. Help us to live our lives in a way that honors Your name. Pray that we will endeavor to share the Good News of salvation to all our family and friends and people whose path we cross.

Monday, (Mar 25): Commit to the Lord all Holy Week Services. Pray that our people will not be hindered from coming. Pray that God will speak to our hearts and renew in us a love for Jesus. Pray that as we reflect on Jesus' journey to the cross, we may once again realize the amazing love that God has poured into our lives. Pray that we will never take for granted God's love in our lives. Pray that we will always seek to live holy lives to the honor and glory of God.

Tuesday, (Mar 26): Pray for all churches across the world and locally to be deeply connected to God during this season of Lent, standing in solidarity and unity in God's love as they extend His love and build His kingdom on earth. Pray for the Stations of the Cross in the hearts of God's people, commemorating our Lord Jesus' journey to Calvary and the various steps he took along the journey. Pray for all Christians as they commemorate the life, ministry, death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus by reflecting on his seven last words before surrendering his spirit on the cross.

Commit to the Lord all speakers and facilitators as they lead in this online event. About 600 students have registered to participate in this program. Pray that these students will have a deeper understanding of Jesus' love and passion for them that would impact their lives. Pray that this event will also create opportunities for the students to engage with those who are abroad.

Friday, (Mar 29): We come before God in gratitude for His faithfulness and love that endure forever, as we remember the pain and suffering that our Lord Jesus endured both before and on the Cross bearing our every sin in order to set us free. May we never take for granted this gracious gift of life that was won by the precious blood of our Lord Jesus. May we always be grateful for His grace and love that we may daily desire to die to sin and to live to righteousness in Him by the help of the Holy Spirit. May we never stop praying for the salvation of our loved ones and friends, and may God continue to grant us boldness and creative ways to share His Word and love with them.

Saturday (Mar 30): Pray for the World: Pray for Haiti. Pray that the violence in the country will cease and the interim government will be formed urgently. Pray for the nation's safety, peace and political stability. Pray that God will protect the people from famine and malnutrition and provide basic needs of every household and hospital. Pray that the sick will be able to get to the hospital safely so that they can receive immediate care and treatment. Pray that God will raise righteous leaders to uphold people's fundamental rights and needs. Pray that God will strengthen Christian and their light will shine in the country, bringing glory to God.
