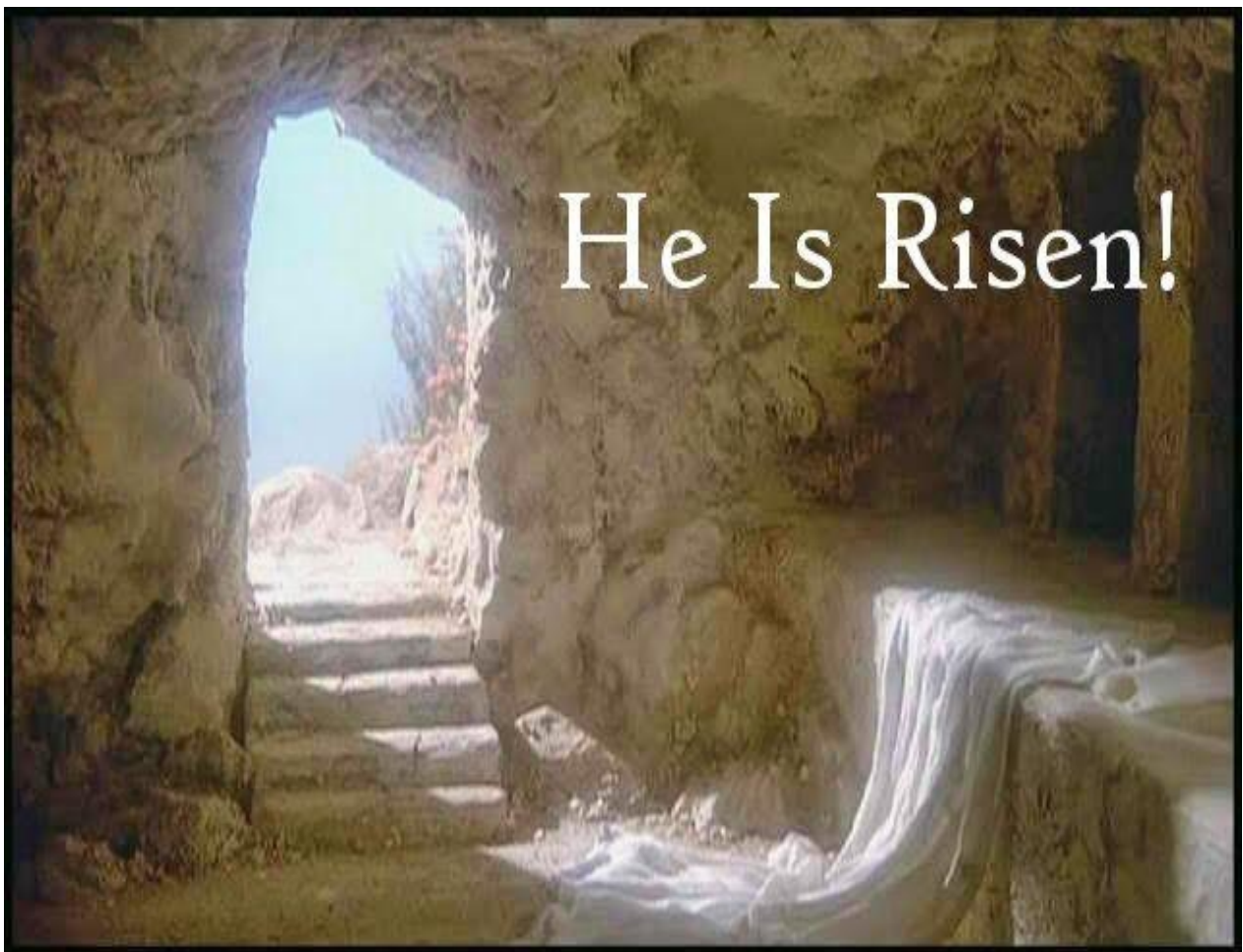

Sunday, (Mar 31) – “And when they looked, they saw that the stone was rolled away: for it was very great.” Give thanks to God for Jesus' resurrection. Indeed, God in His power raised Jesus and have reconciled us back to Himself. Pray that we will never take the love of Jesus for granted. Pray that we will live our lives each day as people redeemed by the love of God. Pray for deep sense of trust in God for just as He has rolled the stone away, He shall remove all the barriers that hinders us from living the life that God has intended for us.
