**Sunday, (Apr 7):** We are called to remember. Remember and give thanks to God for all that God has provided for us. Remember not only the provisions God has provided but remember the gift of eternal life that God has given us through the death and resurrection of Jesus. Pray for a deep sense of gratitude in each of our hearts. Pray that God will keep us humble and grateful by observing all the commands that He has given us. Thank God for the progress made on the Constitution amendments affecting stateless children, and pray that regressive amendments that remain be addressed.

**Thursday, (Apr 11): TRAC: Jeremiah School 2024** - We give thanks to God for giving us the opportunity to host the JS students for their weekend attachment (6-7 Apr & 13-14 Apr). Pray for these students to have a blessed time of learning and experiencing ministry. Pray that as these students learn and experience doing ministry, they will be able to hear God's call in their lives. Commit the JS mentors in prayer as well as they journey with these students. Pray for journey mercies as they travel to Klang from Port Dickson.

**Friday, (Apr 12):** Pray for peace and harmony in this nation. We thank God that Malaysia is home to a diverse range of ethnic cultures that have enriched and impacted one another. Pray that by God's help, His love and mercy, we may learn to trust, respect and appreciate one another despite our differences. In this festive season, may we open our hearts so that we may develop stronger bonds with our neighbours.

**Saturday (Apr 13): Pray for the World:** Pray for Taiwan and the people, as the 7.4 magnitude earthquake hit near the eastern county of Hualien last week, the strongest in 25 years. Pray for God's comfort to be upon those who have lost loved ones and properties. Pray that God will heal those who have been affected by this tragic incident. Pray that there will not be any more aftershocks, that the residents and rescuers will be protected, and search and rescue operations can continue.
