Sunday, (July 7): Lord, we thank you for ministering to us today through Your Word by Your Spirit. Pray that we might be known as Your people by our faith, love, koinonia, service to one another, and doing everything we do for the love of Christ. Pray that we will be the source of comfort to others as well as the source of joy to others. Pray that we, as the embodiment of Your Church, will manifest the kind of Spirit-directed, Spirit-empowered character that is necessary for our hearts to be overflowing with forgiveness.

Monday, (July 8): Church – Thanks be to God for our church’s Social Concern Ministry and for the team’s compassion for the needy in the community. Pray for God’s blessings and guidance to be upon bro. Johnny as he leads the team. Ask God to send more church members to join them as committee members. Pray that we will be more outwardly oriented, reaching out to the needy and underprivileged or impoverished families, and stay connected with them so that we can provide support through the church.

Tuesday, (July 9): Pray for the churches in the world and locally to live and experience the power of the Gospel that they can experience forgiveness, freedom from the bondages of sin, and living life to the fullest. Pray for pastors and church members to honor their vows made at ordination, membership reception, marriage and covenant services, reflecting their responsibility and accountability to God. Pray for the revival of God’s Word across the nation, demonstrating Christ’s Church’s love and hunger for the eternal power of Scripture to transform the nation’s lives.

Wednesday, (July 10): Pray for the Nation – Pray for Youth and Sports Ministry and Minister Hannah Yeoh to intensify Rakan Muda programmes implementation in districts to strengthen unity, national integration, and youth human capital in realising the Madani Youth Development Model 2030. Pray for Azalina Othman Said, the Minister in the Prime in Prime Minister’s Department (Law and Institutional Reform) and the team in the arbitration proceedings to win the Sulu claims dispute and protect our country’s sovereignty. Pray for our Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek to accelerate the educational reform agenda so that the nation’s education standards are upheld, particularly with regard to the restructuring and reform of the preschool system, the 2027 School Curriculum, and curriculum interventions to address student dropout.

Thursday, (July 11): TRAC - Commit to the Lord the work and ministry of the Persidangan Misi Sengoi Malaysia (PMSM). Pray for the PMSM work to be effective among the OA community. Commit to the Lord the PMSM Superintendent, Rev. Ronald Yap as he leads and guides the PMSM. Pray for more leaders to be raised among the OA community. With God’s grace and His guidance, may each of us be faithful ambassador of Christ with a pure heart, speaking with grace, praying diligently and in our obedience to Him.

Saturday (July 13): Pray for the World: Continue to pray for an immediate end to the wars between Palestine and Israel, and Ukraine and Russia, recognizing that many people living in these regions themselves long for peace and reconciliation. Pray for deep awareness that Satan seeks to make warring parties remain two, but our Lord Jesus desires to unite hostile parties into one (Ephesians 2:14-16). Pray for the world leaders to have discernment and humility in choosing the pathway to a just and lasting peace.
